I am to forward the following additional information furnished by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF), Telangana State, Hyderabad in the reference 4^{th} cited (copy enclosed) in respect of the proposal for Diversion of **151.8517** Ha of Forest land falling in Yellandu division for proposed JK OC project at Yellandu division in favour of M/s Singareni Collieries Company Limited as sought in the reference 3^{rd} cited:-

1	The State Government is required to submit the details that how much coal reserve has been excavated from the UG mines so far and how much coal reserve is available in the proposed forest land for diversion with justification for seeking surface rights for open cast mining.	M/s.SCCL has informed that the percentage of extraction of coal in underground mining is very less and the percentage of extraction varies from 20% to 40% depending on the technology and other site-specific conditions. In the present case the geological reserves in the proposed area of 151.8519 ha are 23.334 Mt. The depleted reserve by underground method is only 8.5 Mt which is about 36.42%. In view of existing demand of coal for thermal power plants, sustenance of coal to the linked power plants, and coal conservation with profitability, it is now proposed to convert this underground mine into an opencast mine to extract additional coal reserves of 6.0 MT

which otherwise would have been lost forever. Hence, the total extractable reserves are optimised to 14.5 MT in conservation point of view and thus the percentage of extraction would be about 62.14%.

2 detailed action plan remove the noted encroachment from the 68.00 ha out of 106.3042 ha forest land proposed for diversion as well as in the 18 ha which is part of earlier diverted 124.96 ha shall be submitted. Further, the details of eligible families to be considered as per the provisions of the RFCTLAR Act, 2013 shall be Also, provided. the Government shall clarify, whether any R&R plan is required for the same.

The District Forest Officer, Bhadradri Kothagudem has informed that the illegal encroachment i.e., four (4) rooms with RCC Slab & three (3) rooms permanent shed and running poultry farm business in three shed in Yellandu room compartment No.51 of Joduboulli Beat which is a part of proposed Forest land for diversion of JK OC Project 151.8517 ha are evicted on 07.02.2024 by the then Forest Range Officer, Yellandu and concerned staff. The encroachers were duly served notice & eviction process was taken up and some structures in 106.304 ha forest land area (part of 151.8517 ha proposed for diversion) were dismantled & forest area was retrieved in the presence of the Police Revenue Officials & personnel and the cultivation of crops on field is also hereby stopped.

Further, informed that, a small part of encroached area to an extent of 18.00 ha patch of 124.96 ha earlier diversion area with underground rights, nearly 102 huts are established and 9 houses are constructed with cement bricks in this area. The concerned Deputy Range Officer, Jodubouli and Forest Beat Officer, Jodubouli issued eviction notices to the encroachers i.e., for 15 members and they tried to issue notices to the remaining encroachers. But, concerned the when proceeded to the spot to serve notices, the encroachers are not available in their huts and this encroachment will be cleared with

an action plan in this regard by serving notices to the remaining encroachers. Further he has informed that the SCCL authorities has agree to pay compensation for the eliaible families if any, as per the provisions of the RFCTLARR Act, 2013.
