 2. DFO Rampur has intimated that Geo referenced map has already been submitted to CCF Wildlife Shimla vide DFO Sarahan (WL) office letter No. 2104 dated 12.12.2022, which will be further sent to Nodal Officer -cum- APCCF (FCA) Shimla, and DFO letter has also uploaded on the web portal by the User Agency.
 3. DFO Rampur has submitted the progressive detail/status of funds utilized as on the date under comprehensive CAT Plan which further has been uploaded in the online part-II.
 4. DFO Rampur has submitted the revised bill of NPV in terms of MoEF & CC letter dated 06.01.2022, which further has been uploaded on the web portal in online part-II.
 5. The DFO Rampur intimated that the user agency has submitted the undertaking with regard to submission of FCA certificate before

the stage-II approval and also uploaded on the web portal in online Part-II by the user agency.

DFO Rampur intimated that the User Agency has submitted the revised cost benefit analysis in terms of revised NPV rates dated 06.01.2022 and also uploaded on the web portal by the User Agency in online part I.
