1.0 The scope of consultancy work:

- d) The period for the necessary clarifications, if any, required by the firm on the Design notes and drawing will be up to a period of six month after supply of final Design notes and drawings.
- 1.2 The scope of consultancy work to be carried by DAC shall not include preparation of estimate, tender paper, and scrutiny of tender for the work and related matters in this respect. It will also not include field control and quality control on the construction of work to be done by the firm, however it is obligatory on DGM, Marki Mangali-II, Yazdani International Pvt. Ltd., Post- Wani, Dist. Yavatmal, to furnish a summary of water releases out from the spillways of dams for its further analysis if required.

2.0 PAYMENT OF CONSULTANCY FEES:

The total fees to be paid by DGM, Marki Mangali-II, Yazdani International Pvt. Ltd. Post- Wani, Dist. Yavatmal, will be Rs 10,90,000/- (Rs. Ten Lakh Ninety Thousand Only) excluding G.S.T

Total amount of consultancy fees excluding visit charges of Water Resources Department officials shall be paid in advance, at the time of taking the work in hand and signing of Agreement for the consultancy. The payment shall be made by demand draft in favour of "Executive Engineer, Hydrology Project Division, Aurangabad".

If during course of execution of consultancy work no. of drawings varies the additional fee is binding upon the firm.

3.0 SUPPLY OF DATA FOR THE DESIGNS TO BE DONE:

In normal course, all the data required for the preparation of design notes and drawings to be done under this consultancy shall be supplied by the firm, as and when required. The firm will be entirely responsible for the timely supply and accuracy of the required data and information for the preparation of design notes and drawings. If the data is not given by the firm as per the requirement, there will be delay in supply of design & drawings. The schedule of supply of design notes and drawings will be postponed according to the period of delay in supplying the data for which this organization shall not be held responsible. This organization will not take up the work of designs for the respective components unless required field data is made available. All costs of collection and supply of data as well as testing of materials if needed, for consultancy will be borne by the firm.

If the firm of its own desires certain data collection and investigation to be carried out through the Government Organization like MERI, Mechanical



Organization, I.M.D. New Delhi and IPI division etc. on its behalf, respective organizations may be approached by the firm independently within a reasonable period. The firm will pay to the concerned Organizations the rates applicable plus consultancy charges as per the departmental rules. Suitable time variation may have to be allowed in completing final consultancy assignment to account for some delays, if any, for work which cannot be done with required priority by those organizations.

Similarly, if the Chief Engineer, Hydrology & Dam Safety, Nashik specifically desires (for certain specific reasons) that for the present consultancy job certain investigations, additional data required to be collected by other Government Organization, the firm shall be bound to get these data from the respective organizations on payment as billed by the respective organizations.

4.0 ESTIMATED PERIOD OF COMPLETION OF CONSULTANCY WORK:

- 4.1 Subject to timely receipt of the required data in the stipulated form from time to time, the consultancy work shall be completed within a period of <u>six</u> months (For Design Flood Estimation only) from the month of receipt of full data and receipt of full consultancy charges. The schedule of supply of design notes and drawings will get postponed according to the period of delay in supplying the data for which Superintending Engineer, Data Analysis Circle, Nashik shall not be held responsible.
- 4.2 If the data required from time to time is not received from the firm within a stipulated period, the Data Analysis Circle, Nashik may have to be consider termination of consultancy work, and in that case, the firm shall be liable for action under para 5.0 below.

5.0 TERMINATION OF CONSULTANCY WORK:

If the firm of its own desires for termination of the consultancy work before completion or in contingency arising out of para 4.2 above the amount already paid to Data Analysis Circle for the consultancy work will not be refunded.
