

JOINT INSPECTION REPORT

(Parshanti Hydro Energies Pvt. Ltd. 0.5MW Lingti SHEP)

The Joint Inspection of Parshanti Hydro (Lingti 0.5MW SHEP), was conducted jointly by the representatives of the Divisional Forest Officer, the Range Officer and Naib Tahsildar Palampur, dated 09-01-2014, along with the supporting staff and representatives of M/s Parshanti Hydro Energies Pvt. Ltd, Sai Sankalp, Bagher Road, Panchrukhi, Tehsil Palampur, District Kangra, Himachal Pradesh - 176103. Neogal Khad near Village Rakh, Tehsil Palampur, Distt. Kangra, Himachal Pradesh. The undersigned have jointly inspected the areas proposed for diversion for the aforesaid project, which lies in Tehsil Palampur, Distt. Kangra, H.P.

The survey for the above mentioned project was conducted on 3-different routes / alternatives, that is - (Route / Alternative No.1, Route / Alternative No. 2 and Route / Alternative No. 3). We have explored all the possibilities during the outside visit, we have observed that the Route No. 1 has more forest land with trees and Route No.3 has Private lands with trees. Hence these 2-alternative routes were rejected. We have proposed Route No.2, which involves minimum forest & government land, with no trees and no private land. Total land area 01-11-77 hectares involved for the project is inclusive of transmission lines and road up to the powerhouse.

The project requires 01-11-63 hectare of Forest Land & 0-00-14 hectare of Government land, totaling to a total project land area of 01-11-77 hectares, for the construction of different components viz., Intake on Lingti Khad, Desilting Tank, Power Pipe, Powerhouse, Switchyard, Muck Dumping Sites, Approach Road to the Power House and Transmission Line from Power House to the Interconnection point.

The width of the transmission line proposed to be acquired is 7 m right of way and the height is 11 meter. The transmission line from the Project shall be built from the proposed Power House to the Inter Connection Point. The Approach Road shall follow the village track for most of the length and thereafter the transmission will also be laid on the road alignment.

The Joint Inspection team has examined all the alternatives / routes with a view to avoid / minimize the use of forest & government land and also to not to encroach upon any private land and hence we have come to the conclusion that, the land of the below mentioned Khasra Nos. of forest land & govt. land is available and is the barest minimum requirement for the proposed project and so is absolutely essential.





TO WHOM SO EVER IT MAY CONCERN

In compliance of the Ministry of Environment and Forest (MoEF), Govt. of India's letter No.11-9/98-FC(pt.) dated 3rd August, 2009 wherein the MoEF issued guidelines on submission of evidences for having initiated and completed the process of settlement of rights under the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 (FRA, for short) on the forest land proposed to be diverted for non-forest purposes read with MOEF's letter dt 5th February 2013 wherein MOEF issued certain relaxation in respect of linear projects, it is certified that 01-11-63 Hectares situated in Mohal Rakh, Tehsil Palampur, Distt. Kangra, of forest land proposed to be diverted in favour of Parshanti Hydro Energies Private Limited for construction of Lingti SHP (0.5 MW) in the state of H.P in Tehsil Palampur falls within the jurisdiction of Palampur Forest Division.

It is further certified that:

- (a) The complete process for identification and settlement of rights under the FRA has been carried out for the entire 01-11-63 hectares of forest area proposed for diversion. A copy of records of all consultations and meetings of the Forest Rights Committee(s), Gram Sabha(s), Sub Divisional Level Committee(s) and the District Committee are enclosed as annexures. As per report received from Gram Panchayat, Rakh and SDO (C) Palampur there are no claims pending under them from anyone as per Scheduled Tribes and forest dwellers act 2006.
- (b) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabha has given their consent to it.
- (c) The proposal does not involve recognized right of primitive Tribal group and pre agriculture communities.
