
महोदय,

उपरोक्त विषयांतर्गत निवेदन है कि आलौच्य प्रत्यावर्तन प्रकरण में भारत सरकार के संदर्भित पत्र दिनांक 20 अप्रैल, 2022 से प्राप्त आक्षेपों की उप वन संरक्षक, भरतपुर द्वारा संदर्भित पत्र से निम्नानुसार पूर्ति कर प्रस्ताव ऑनलाईन इस कार्यालय को प्रेषित किया है :-

1.	As per DSS analyses, 15.30 ha. of proposed forest area is within in the eco-sensitive zone of Band Baretha Wildlife Sanctuary. As per the site specific observation of DCF Bharatpur, it has been highly recommended that no mining lease should be given in this area. The State Govt has also recommended the proposal subject to the suggestions in recommendations given by the NO/CCF/DCF. The State Govt may therefore revisit the proposal and since 15.30 ha area is to be kept out of the mining lease, therefore the revised maps/documents may be submitted accordingly.	Boundaries of Bandh Baretha Wild lfe Sanctuary has been rationalized wide order no F1(71)Van/Bandh Baretha/02 Dated 23.03.2021 and subsequently the proposal for modification of Eco-Sensitive Zone of Bandh Baretha Wildlife Sanctuary has been forwarded to APCCF And Chief Wildlife Warden, Rajasthan, Jaipur on date 03.03.2022 after due process. The Proposed new Eco Sensitive Zone of Bandh Baretha Wildlife Sanctuary does not lie inside the proposed mining area by user agency, this was clearly mentioned in site specific recommendations of DCF (uploaded in additional information)
2.	The total cost of Compensatory Afforestation indicated on PARIVESH portal is Rs.688.67 lakh whereas the total cost as per the CA Scheme prepared by the DCF, Bharatpur is Rs.950.6739 lakh. The variation may be verified and the CA scheme approved by the competent authority be uploaded on the PARIVESH portal.	Total CA Scheme for Rs 950.6739 lakh has been uploaded in Part II

3	As mentioned in the recommendations of DCF/CCF the detailed mining plan has not been submitted. The state govt. may therefore submit a copy of approved mining plan/ detailed cluster mining plan incorporating the scope of common green infrastructure for all sub-leases to optimize resources and minimize ecological impact.	Submitted by User Agency
4	The Cost Benefit analysis has not been prepared as per the guidelines issued by the ministry in this regard. The same may therefore be revised keeping in view the guidelines as well as the revised rates of NPV.	Submitted by User Agency
5	The proposal is in continuation of an earlier proposal no. FP/RAJ/MIN/125714/2021 including an area of 398.0085 ha for which Stage-II approval has been issued by the Central Government. The reasons/justification for submitting the proposals in piecemeal may therefore be submitted.	Justification given by User Agency That Out of 646.56 ha of forest area block A and B of Pahadpur, The Proposal for diversion of 398.0085 ha. excluding the area of effective mining leases was applied on 13.04.2021 on the Parivesh Portal. Second approval of the said area 398.0085 ha. was issued on 11.03.2022. If the entire forest area of the said forest block is not diverted, then it will be impossible to control illegal mining activities in future. Therefore, it has been decided by the state government to repatriate the remaining area of 248.5515 ha.
6	The kml file indicating the area proposed for safety zone has not been submitted, which is required to be done.	Uploaded by user agency.
7	The State Govt has proposed 300 ha area in four patches of DFL to plant the remaining plants which can not be accommodated in the CA area. As per DSS analysis certain encroachments are visible in the Shahpur area. The State Govt shall therefore ensure that the area proposed for CA and planting the remaining plants is free from all encumbrances and submit a certificate to this effect.
