With reference to the above proposal seeking Stage-I approval submitted by this office letter dated 19-03-2020 vide Ref (1) and by the Government of Karnataka letter dated 05-06-2020 vide Ref (2), the Government of India vide Ref (3) had raised the EDS Query seeking certain additional information. The same was communicated by the Government of Karnataka letter dated 28-09-2020 vide Ref (2) to this office. Accordingly, this office letter dated 06-11-2020 vide Ref (1) has forwarded the same to the field officers and further to User Agency.

In response, the User Agency vide Ref (4) has submitted the information sought by the Government of India, that has been forwarded to this office through FC web portal by the field officers vide Ref (5) & (6).

Based on the reply furnished by the User Agency and the information available in the proposal, the following reply is submitted to the query raised by Government of India.

Due to the unavailability of nonforest land or private land, the work has started in the diverted forest area in favour of Project Seabird. Hence, the Forest Department informed the National Highway Authority of India to submit a re-diversion proposal in Parivesh Web Portal.
