

Sub: Proposal for diversion of 0.58 ha of forest land in favour of Reliance Jio Infocom for laying of OFC from Jaldhaka Bridge to Kumani along with Chapramari Railway Station-Kumani more under Kalimpong and Jalpaiguri Division-reg.

Sir.

This is to bring into your kind notice that a query raised by Assistant Inspector General of Forest vide letter no: IRO/KOL/Jio-01/2022/FC/66, Dated 28-02/2022, This office in response to the query has provided all the details given below and uploading them on "Parivesh Portal" for further consideration of the proposal.

Point no 1: On perusal of the .kml file of the proposed location on parivesh portal, it has been observed that vegetation is present in the area whereas in part II Pt.4 details of vegetation available is given nil by DFO Jalpaiguri".

"In compliance to the above query, a new degraded forest land was identified and corresponding KML file along with the Site Suitability Certificate was uploaded in the Parivesh portal for the purpose of Compensatory afforestation by the undersigned (Copy Enclosed)

Point no 2: In PART-II pt. 8(i), DFO stated that wild animal's viz., barking deer, jackal, elephant and leopard are present and further DFOs of both the Divisions stated that rare/endangered/unique species of flora and fauna are found in the proposed area. In connection to these observations, comments of CWLW on the presence of endangered animals in two divisions and Bio- diversity Management Plans duly signed by competent authority are required.

The project may not have much significant impact on the movement of the wild animals and rare flora in the region as the proposal is for laying underground optical fibre cable. Since the area is falling within the Eco Sensitive Zones of Chaparamari Wildlife Sanctuary comments from the CWLW/appropriate authority may be taken.

Point no 3: Sol Toposheet of proposed CA land is not uploaded on PARIVESH portal.

In compliance to the above query, the new Sol Toposheet of proposed CA land is uploaded in Part II pt. 13(iv) (Copy Enclosed)

<u>Point no 4:</u> Location map of proposed site indicating longitude and latitude is not signed by concerned DFOs.

"In compliance to the above query, the new signed Location map of proposed site indicating longitude and latitude uploaded in Part II pt. 13(iii)" (Copy Enclosed)

Point no 5: FRA certificate for both the districts are not submitted

"In compliance to the above query, FRA NOC from DM ,Jalpaiguri uploaded in Part I pt. L, in Additional information Details sl no. 8" (Copy Enclosed)

<u>Point no 6:</u> Site inspection report submitted by DFO Kalimpong stated that "It has been found that the user agency has violated (Conservation), Act and 1980 provisions. Details report as per para 1.9 of Chapter 1, Para C of Hand Book of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 attached" but no such report is submitted with the proposal. A detailed report along with photographs is required.

Query, it is not related to DFO, Jalpaiguri"

<u>Point no 7:</u> Revised NPV must be submitted vide File No.5-3/2011-FC (vol-I) of Ministry of Environment Forest and Climate Change needs to be submitted.

As per the revision of rates of net present Value vide File No:5-3/2011-FC (Vol-I) dated 6th January 2022 by the AIG Forests, MoEF&CC, Forest Conservation Division for laying of underground optical fibre cable full exemption is provided as per 4(xi) where no felling of trees is involved and areas falling out side National Park/Sanctuary. The proposed area for diversion under Jalpaiguri Forest Division is a Reserve Forest area and the proposal doesn't involve any felling of trees. However, the NPV calculation is also done as per the existing guidelines for necessary attention. (Copy Enclosed)

<u>Point no 8:</u> DFO mentioned that proper soil and moisture conservation measures have to be taken up while using forest land for these purposes 'hut no SMC plan is submitted along with the CA plan, therefore SMC plan is required.

The project does not cause much soil erosion in the region and is underground in nature so no SMC plan is proposed.




