The Government of India, MoEF&CC, Jor Bag Road, Aliganj, New Delhi vide letter under reference No. 1 has raised query on 17 points.

Accordingly, The Chief Conservator of Forests (T), Kolhapur vide letter under reference No.2 has submitted the compliance reports on 17 points to this office. The same may be submitted as under:

In view of the above facts, the aforesaid compliance submitted for further necessary action.

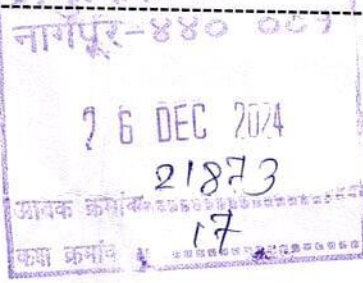

Govt. of Maharashtra vide notification No. WLP,1999/C.R.-117/F-1 dated 14-05-2004 declared Chandoli Sanctuary as Chandoli National Park by adding Amboli village's geographical area to the National Park. However, Villages -Niwale, Tanali, Chandel, Dakale, Tambave Paiki Kulyachiwadi, Sonarli paiki dhangarwada Tal-Shahuwadi Dist- Kolhapur, And Village Gothane, Sangmeshwar Tahsil dist- Ratnagiri this villages included in Chandoli, National Park due to people affected in this project for this reason forest area 318.04 ha diverted for agriculture use due to affected persons selected the forest area for agriculture in Walur, Karanjoshi, Kotoli, Perid, Bhairewadi, Jeur, Porle Traf Thane, Madale, Pargaon, Ambapwadi, Male, Vadgao, Tasgao, Danoli and Tamdalge. Hence, proposal has been submitted under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for disforestation.

On the said proposal, the central government has raised sought back query on 1 to 17 points in the above reference letter number-1. It has been reported to this office by Additional Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer Nagpur. All those back quarries 1 to 17 have been addressed through this office.

A detailed compliance report prepared by this office and it is being submitted along with the necessary documents, maps, certificates, along with the KML file with CD. Also, the said back quarry compliance report and KML files has been uploaded online on PARIVESH portal.

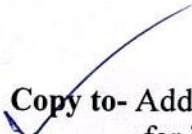

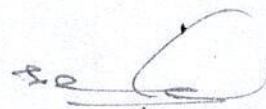

The process of relocation of the affected people for the purpose of rehabilitation is complex. Decision of forest land for rehabilitation/relocation requires selection/acceptance by the affected people. While the process is going on, the land for diversion which was selected/accepted by the people was necessitated to be finalized, though partial, for the diversion purpose. Hence the diversion proposal is being submitted in phased manner.
