Sir,

Kindly refer to your office letter FC/HPB/06/64/2021 dated 17.01.2022 on the subject cited proposal.

2. The pointwise reply to the observation as raised vide your above referred communication is submitted as below:-

1. The record of all consultations and meeting with Gram Sabha(s) and FRC (s) has been uploaded online portal now.
2. As per the user agency, the suitable non-forest/private land is not available to be explored for dumping sites.
3. A separate list of trees standing in muck dumping site has been prepared and uploaded on the online portal part- II in additional information detail at Sr. No.2.
4. The detail regarding purpose wise break up of forest land and non-forest land involved in the proposal is uploaded online part- I in B-2.4.
5. Linear map has been uploaded in the online portal against the additional information at Sr.13 Part-I.
6. The selected area of CA in (DPF Kerag) is recorded as "Jangal Mehfooza Mehduda" in the revenue record (copy of Jamabandi is uploaded online portal).

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7. The revised NPV has been prepared as per current rates and was uploaded on the portal against the additional information at Sr.3 Part-II.
8. Needful has been done.
9. Project approval documents now have been uploaded in the portal.
10. DFO Chopal has informed that all measures of erosion will be taken while preparing of DPR of formation, cutting and protection works will be provided as per site requirements for ecological restoration of adjoining forest land.
11. The provision of crate wire walls with proper design be adopted to protect natural water streams/nalla and there shall be no any damages of natural water streams/nalla.
12. The dumping site have been selected at suitable places adjoin to road alignment and muck produced during the construction of road shall protected by which no slope shall be required by the user agency.
13. Necessary correction has been done.
14. All EDS compliance related annexure has been uploaded on the MeEF Portal in additional detail.
