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Kind attention is invited to the subject and references cited above.

It is submitted that the processed proposal for diversion of **2.6325 ha** (Revised from 4.1083 ha) of forest land for BT Road from **"R/F PWD Road to Jhaduguda** (PWD Road to Kishan Thanda) in Bheempur RF Block, Asifabad forest division of Komurambheem Asifabad District in favour of District Panchayath Raj, Engineer (PIU), Komurambheem Asifabad District, was submitted to the IRO, MoEF&CC, Gol, Hyderabad by State Govt vide ref 2<sup>nd</sup> cited.

The IRO, MoEF&CC, Gol, Hyderabad vide ref 3<sup>rd</sup> cited has returned 11 proposals (the subject proposal is one among them) which were submitted to them after 28.06.2022, with a request to process the same as per the provisions of FC Rules, 2022.

Accordingly, User Agency was requested to take immediate necessary action in submission of proposals as per the provisions of FC Rules, 2022 vide ref 4<sup>th</sup> cited.

As the case is such, the MoEF&CC, Gol, New Delhi vide Lr.dt.14.11.2022 has issued guidelines w.r.t processing of proposal pertaining to proposal uploaded on Parivesh 1.0 for want of availability of complete end to end functionality of FC module in

Parviesh 2.0 as per the FC Rules, 2022.

As per para 3 (i), of the said guidelines.

".....proposals submitted in PARIVESH 1.0 after 28.06.2022 and not migrated to PARIVESH 2.0, may be processed using the FC module of PARIVESH 1.0. However to adhere the procedures laid down in the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022, the minutes of the meeting of Project Steering Committee (PSC) may be attached with part-IV of forms and passing of proposals of less than 5 ha through Conservator of Forests, may be treated inert for procedural/ technical purposes...."

As per para 3 (iii), of the said guidelines.

".....proposals, already submitted in the PARIVESH 2.0 at various levels, may be processed in offline mode by the processing authorities of the State/UT concerned following the statutory process provided in the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022...."

In this particular case, the proposal has already been submitted to IRO, MoEF&CC, Gol, Hyderabad in Parviesh1.0 and as per the para 3 (i), proposal can be processed now, as the area proposed for diversion is less than 5.00 Ha, placing of the proposal before the Project Screening Committee (PSC) as per the FC Rules, 2022 is not necessary.

In view of the facts mentioned above, the Govt. is requested to forward the above replies to the Gol, MoEF&CC, Hyderabad for according necessary approval for the project.

**Sub: Processing of proposals, in PARIVESH 1.0 for want of availability of complete end-to-end functionality of FC module in PARIVESH 2.0 as per the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022 – reg.**

Madam/Sir,

I am directed to refer to this Ministry's letter of even number dated 18.07.2022 and 15.09.2022 on the above subject and to say that the progress made by the NIC to develop online facility in *Parivesh 2.0* for processing forest land diversion cases as per the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022 was reviewed in the Ministry.

2. It has been observed that many proposals in the PARIVESH 1.0 (proposals submitted by user agencies and accepted by the Nodal Officer (FCA)) are stuck up at various stages of processing in the State/UT and migration of such proposals to PARIVESH 2.0 may further delay the processing of these proposals. Similarly, proposals in PARIVESH 2.0 are also held up due to various technical issues.

3. Therefore, to resolve the situation, the Ministry has decided the following:

- i. Proposals submitted in PARIVESH 1.0 after 28.06.2022 and not migrated to PARIVESH 2.0, may be processed using the FC module of PARIVESH 1.0. However to adhere the procedures laid down in the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022, the minutes of the meeting of Project Steering Committee (PSC) may be attached with part-IV of forms and passing of proposals of less than 5 ha through Conservator of Forests, may be treated inert for procedural/technical purposes.
- ii. Till a time, the stabilization issues in PARIVESH 2.0 are resolved, new proposals may be submitted in PARIVESH 1.0 and their processing may be done as per arrangement mentioned under para 3 (i) above.
- iii. Proposals, already submitted in the PARIVESH 2.0 at various levels, may be processed in offline mode by the processing authorities of the State/UT concerned following the statutory process provided in the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022.
- iv. After rolling out of complete functionalities of the FC modules on PARIVESH

2.0, as envisaged in the Forest (Conservation) Rules, 2022, details of proposals processed in offline mode, as indicated under para 3 (iii) above, will be updated in the PARIVESH 2.0 by the authorities/user agency concerned.

In view of the above, I am directed to request the State Governments/UT Administrations to take appropriate action for processing such proposals and to accordingly inform the user agencies.
