Please refer to your office Endst No. D-VI-175(M)/1520 dated 16.07.2020 on the subject cited above.

It is submitted that 11.0668 ha. area has already been identified in UPF Dhango of Ghumarwin range and as per observation raisec by GoI vide letter No. 8B/HP/06/2020/FC/2350 dated 27.01.2020, out of above 11.0668 ha. area, 8ha area falls in MDF. Keeping in view of this 8 ha area has been identified in UPF Chab of Swarghat range and land suitability certificate, digital map and toposheet of above 8 ha are has been sent to your office vide this office letter No. D-Blp/Link road Khal Tiba(5.5334)/2945 dated 04.07.2020. The earlier proposed area of 11.0668 ha in UPF Dhango out of which GoI has found 8 ha MDF is got re-checked/ inspected from RO Ghumarwin who has reported after spot verification the above 8 ha area is infested with lantana and other type of bushes upto 75% as such it shows MDF in DSS analysis. The above forest land is having corwn density below 20% as such this area falls under Open Forest which is suitable for raising of CA as per FCA guidelines. As such, 8 ha area proposed in UPF Chab vide this office letter No. 2945 dated 04.07.2020 is withdrawn. The land Suitability certificate, digital map and toposheet of above 11.0668 ha area has already been sent to your office letter No. 9889 dated 07.01.2019.

Besides this, the user agency has marked the proposed road, existing road locations of beneficiary villages and dumping sites have been marked in distinct colors in KML file & digital map. Similarly the beneficiary village/population has also been marked in circle. The distance of beneficiary villages from existing road namely Swarghat Shree Naina Devi Ji Bhakra road through the alignment of proposed road which bifurcates at RD 26/915 to Khal Tibba is 7.00 Kms. The population of this village Khal Tibba is in the scattered manner and mostly the Bhakra Dam Oustees reside there. So the provide the connectivity to this scattered population and Dam Oustees (certificate of beneficiary village attached), the road has been proposed beyond main Khal Tibba habitation keeping in view the hilly Terrain and to provide all weather road connectivity to this scattered population. The enclosures received vide your letter under reference are sent herewith in original for favour of information & further necessary action at your end please.
