No. Ft(a)-1/5/52:- In exercise of the powers conferred by Section 29 of the Indian Forest Act, (Act XVI of 1927); as applied to Bilaspur State, the Chief Commissioner is pleased to declare that from the date of this Notification the provisions of Chapter IV of that Act shall be applicable to all such Government lands in the Bilaspur State which in the Second Land Revenue Settlement papers have been recorded as "the property of the Government or over which the Government has proprietary rights, but are not assessed to revenue; except Mahduda forests (Demarcated Forests) and those area which may from time to time be appropriated for cultivation, or for other purposes with the sanction of the Government."
