Point No. (i)	The reply of the Sl. No.10 of Govt. of Assam forwarding letter No. FRS.253/ 2018/ 60,dated. 20/12/2018. There is no violation of the Forest Conservation Act,1980 in the area proposed for diversion.
Point No. (ii)	A fresh approach road is not required for running of the proposed 5 Ha. Nakkati Hill Stone Quarry No.2 as the proposed area for extraction of minor mineral is adjacent to the non-forest land. A report received for DFO, Aie Valley Division vide his letter No. A/AVD/New Mining Area/92, dated. 17/01/2019 is enclosed herewith.


