UPON hearing the counsel the Court made the following ORDER

INTERLOCUTORY APPLICATION NOS.41909 of 2022, 41415 and 41420 of 2022:

I.A.No.41909 of 2022 has been filed by the State of Himachal Pradesh and I.A.Nos. 41415 and 41420 of 2022 have been filed by SJVN Ltd. for relaxing the restrictions imposed on diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006. A further direction is sought to permit the State of Himachal to issue formal orders for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of 12 projects mentioned in para 7 of the application.

After examining the request made by the State of Himachal Pradesh, the learned Amicus Curiae appearing for CEC submitted that clearance may been granted to the State of Himachal Pradesh as sought for in the application.

The State of Himachal Pradesh is permitted to issue formal orders for diversion of forest land under the forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for construction of 12 projects mentioned in para 7 of I.A. No.41909/2022.

I.As are accordingly allowed.

### INTERLOCUTORY APPLICATION NO.59886 of 2022:

This application is filed by the of Himachal Pradesh for relaxing the restrictions imposed by an order dated 11.03.2019 for diversion of forest land under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and under the Scheduled Tribes and other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of forest Rights) Act, 2006.

10 projects, the particulars of which have been mentioned in para 7 this I.A can be permitted to proceed and relevant orders may be passed by the Himachal Pradesh for diversion of forest land under the (Conservation) Act, 1980. In respect of 14 cases, the details of which have been mentioned at para 8 relates to FRA, 2006. Permission is granted to the State of Himachal Pradesh to issue formal orders for diversion of forest land for the said 14 projects as mentioned in para 8 subject to an undertaking being filed by the State Government to the effect the compulsory afforestation would be undertaken for the area that requires to be diverted for the said projects.

I.A is accordingly allowed.

## INTERLOCUTORY APPLICATION NOS.168463 and 168479 of 2021:

Relaxing of restriction imposed on diversion of forest land under the Forest conservation Act, 1980 vide order dated 11.03.2019 is sought in these applications filed by Mr. Randeep Singh who carries on the activity of "Extractions of river bed minerals". Another direction was sought to direct the State of Himachal Pradesh to issue formal orders for grant of Stage II Compliance/Final

Approval for diversion of land use from forest to nonforest use after compliance of all conditions specified thereto as per rule 8 of the Forest Conservation Rules, 2003.

The CEC has recommended that the applications can be allowed, subject to the applicant paying an amount of Rs.6,15,81,436/- towards NPV and the applicant obtaining required permissions such as EC, FC, approved Mining Plan, consent to operate etc.

On behalf of the State of Himachal Pradesh, Mr. Tushar Mehta, learned Solicitor General submitted that necessary orders may be passed on payment of NPV and compliance of the conditions that are imposed by the Government, Ministry of Environment forests and climate change in its letter dated 02.03.2021 written to the Additional Chief Secretary Forests, Government of Himachal Pradesh.

Mr. Siddhartha Dave, learned senior counsel appearing for the applicant submitted that payment of money towards NPV shall be done within a week from today.

Subject to the compliance of other conditions to be imposed by the Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change and payment of Rs.6,15,81,436/-, the State government is directed to pass suitable orders for diversion of 54.668 ha. of forest land for non-forestry use.

I.As are accordingly allowed.
