PERMIT TERMS AND CONDITIONS

Period from 17.10.95 to 31.3.96

1. The area covered by the permit (hereinafter referred to as the said land) shall not be used for any purpose other than the one specified in the permit and the permit holder shall not encroach upon adjacent lands.
2. No structures or buildings of a permanent or temporary nature shall be effected except such buildings of a temporary nature as may be required, with previous permission in writing of the District Forest Officer, for the time being (hereinafter called the D.F.O)
3. The permit holder shall be responsible for any illicit fellings or remove from Reserved Forest either by himself or by his servants agents, agents and Mazdoors within a radius of two furlongs (0.420 Km) from the said land.
4. The permit holder shall not assign or sublet or part with the possession of the said land or any part thereof or any of his rights under this permit without the previous permission in writing of the District Forest Officer, without assigning any reason for such refusal.
5. The permits holders shall comply at all times with the provisions of the Tamil nadu Forest Act 1882. (Tamilnadu Act V of 1882) and any subsisting statutory modifications there of and all rules from time to time in force thereunder respectively.
6. No standing tree growth or any forest produce except have been specifically permitted in writing by the District Forest Officer shall be cut or removed either from the said land or from the adjoining R.F..
7. The permit holder shall carry out such soil conservation measures as may be directed by the forest departments.
8. All the reserved trees below the lines shall be preserved and protected.

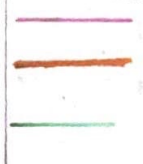
