Sir,

In inviting a reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that Government of India, MoEF & CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar has requested to furnish compliance to 2 (two) nos. of observations. The point wise compliance basing on the reports of the DFO, Baripada Forest Division and FD, STR-cum-RCCF, Baripada Circle are as follows:-

Observation (a): The State Govt. has not furnished the detailed action taken report against the erring official responsible for causing diversion of forest land for non-forestry use without prior approval under Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.

**Compliance:** In compliance to the observation, the FD, STR-cum-RCCF, Baripada Circle has reported that the Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj vide Letter No.4611/Rev dated 24.09.2025 has submitted a detailed action taken report which is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

Observation (b)-: The State Govt. has not intimated the name of person / designation who has allotted the instant forest land to the user agency.

**Compliance:** In compliance to the observation, the FD, STR-cum-RCCF, Baripada Circle has reported that the Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj has submitted the name of person/designation of the official vide letter No.4611/Rev dated 24.09.2025 which is enclosed as **Annexure-I**.

In view of the above, the compliance to the observations of Government of India, MoEF & CC, Regional Office, Bhubaneswar dated 18.02.2025 is sent herewith for favour of kind information and necessary action.

Since the Hal status of the said land was deemed leasable, Lease Case No. 06/2002 was initiated for lease out the above government land in favour of the Mayurbhanj College of Accountancy and Management, Baripada on 05.06.2002. In the meanwhile, administrative approval for construction of a boundary wall was granted under the MLALAD scheme by the then Collector & District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj vide order dated 03.05.2003. Based on requisition from the P.A., ITDA, Baripada (the executing agency), the land was demarcated for construction purposes.

It is pertinent to mention that although the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 came into effect on 25.10.1980, in the absence of clear guidelines for diversion of forest land for non-forest purposes, necessary clarifications were issued by the Revenue & Disaster Management Department in subsequent years vide letters No. 17450 dated 17.06.2014, No. 22958 dated 04.08.2014, No. 31312 dated 24.10.2014, and No. 4822dated 12.02.2015. Upon receipt of clarification from the Chief Secretary of Odisha vide Letter No. 4822 dated 12.02.2015, the procedural uncertainties regarding diversion of forest land were resolved.



Subsequently, the Sabak report from the Settlement Office was obtained on 06.05.2019 through a certified copy submitted by the User Agency, which confirmed that the Sabak Kisam of the land is "Jungle". Therefore, it is clarified that the Forest (Conservation) Act was not enforced earlier due to the lack of clear directives.

Further, clarification was also sought by the Additional District Magistrate, Mayurbhanj from the Revenue & Disaster Management Department vide Letter No. 3170/Rev. dated 07.12.2019. Upon receipt of clarification from the R&DM Department vide Letter No. 12667/R&DM dated 16.03.2020 (copy enclosed), the User Agency/Secretary, MCAM, was requested to submit a formal application to the DFO, Baripada for diversion of the said forest land. The forest diversion proposal is now under active process.



Sub: Sanction of lease of Govt. land measuring Ac. 2.200 in Mouza-Maharajpur, Dist.-Mayurbhanj in favour of Mayurbhanj College of Accountancy & Management (MCAM), Baripada.

Ref: Letter No.3170/Rev, dtd.07.12.2019 of ADM, Mayurbhanj

In inviting a reference to the subject cited above, I am directed to say Sir, that as per this Department G.O No. 4822/CS dated 12/02/2015 issued under the signature of Chief Secretary, Odisha, a land which has been classified as 'forest' as on 25.10.1980 is to be treated as forest irrespective of the fact that the classification has been changed to non-forest kisam subsequently by a statutory process. Where the present RoR of a land has been published after 25.10.1980, the old RoR has to be referred to in order to ascertain if such land was forest as on 25.10.1980. And if the land was forest as on the date 25.10.1980, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 will be applicable and forest diversion has to be done accordingly.

- In the present case, though the process of settlement operation started from 1975, the final RoR was published during 1985 i.e. after 25.10.1980. So, as per the circular issued by Chief Secretary, the old RoR has to be referred to. In the old RoR i.e. in the Sabik record, the kisam of the land was forest. Thus, FC Act, 1980 will be applicable in the present case.
- You are, therefore, requested to advise the Coilege authorities to apply before the Nodal Officer authorized by the State Government to deal with forest conservation matters under the FC Act, 1980 by following due procedure as prescribed in rule 6 of the FC Rules, 2003 to use the forest land in question for non-forest purpose. This shall be subject to the condition that the user agency

i.e. Mayurbhanj College of Accountancy & Management (MCAM), Baripad & shall provide required extent of land for compensatory afforestation purpose which is to be mutated in the name of Forest & Environment Department. On the other hand, if the user agency is unable to provide such land and if suitable Govt. land is available, Revenue & D.M. Department may provide such required land to the user agency for compensatory afforestation purpose subject to payment of premium of the land by the user agency.
