Please refer to your office letter No. dated 13-09-2022 on the subject cited above.

2. The point wise reply of the observations as raised vide letter under reference is as under:-

1. The density of proposed area has been reviewed and mentioned in the online and hard copy of Part-II, copy of which is enclosed herewith.
2. The all components as shown in the layout plan has been mentioned in online portal by the user agency.
3. The norms/guidelines/ notification laid down by the Government for Atal Adarsh Model Schools are enclosed herewith.
4. The project approval of competent authority is enclosed herewith.
5. The brief not of proposal on the activities of the project has been uploaded in online Part-I. However, the hard copy of the same is enclosed herewith.
6. The CA site has now been changed and hard copy of the same is enclosed herewith.
7. The layout plan delineating all the components of Atal Adarsh Vidyalaya is enclosed herewith.
8. In this regard CCF Chamba has reported that all over in the vicinity is either forest land or under cultivation by the local habitants which is very meager. The acquiring of private land will deprive the poor villagers of their only source of livelihood. It is further submitted that in Himachal Pradesh particularly in Chamba District, out of total 6522 sq.km, 5522 Sq.km is forest land, which is approximate 84% of the total area of Chamba District and only 16% of the area of total area in Chamba district comprises in private/ non-forest land. As such there is no suitable non-forest land available for construction of above educational institute. Hence, it is unavoidable to locate the project outside the forest land.

9. In this regard it is submitted that the project required at least 35 Bighas land which is not available in the non-forest land, also the farmers / land owner of the concerned area are not agreed for gift deed/ sale such a huge land for the said project/ purpose.

1	(A) <u>Introduction and background</u> In the 1 st para i.e. introduction / background it was provided that admission /selection process will be started from nursery standard.	Admission/selection process will start from 6th class. The Government of Himachal Pradesh has envisaged the need of setting up of residential schools known as Atal Adarsh Vidyalaya (AAV) that would bring out the best of talent from each constituency of the state of Himachal Pradesh. It was felt that children with special talent or aptitude should be provided opportunities to progress at a faster pace by making good quality education available to them irrespective of their capacity to pay for it. Such education would enable students from different areas of the constituencies to compete with their counterparts on an equal footing. Its significance lies in the selection of talented children (especially girls) as the target group and the attempt to provide them with quality education comparable to the best in a residential school system and fifty percent of the such schools will be opened only for girl students.

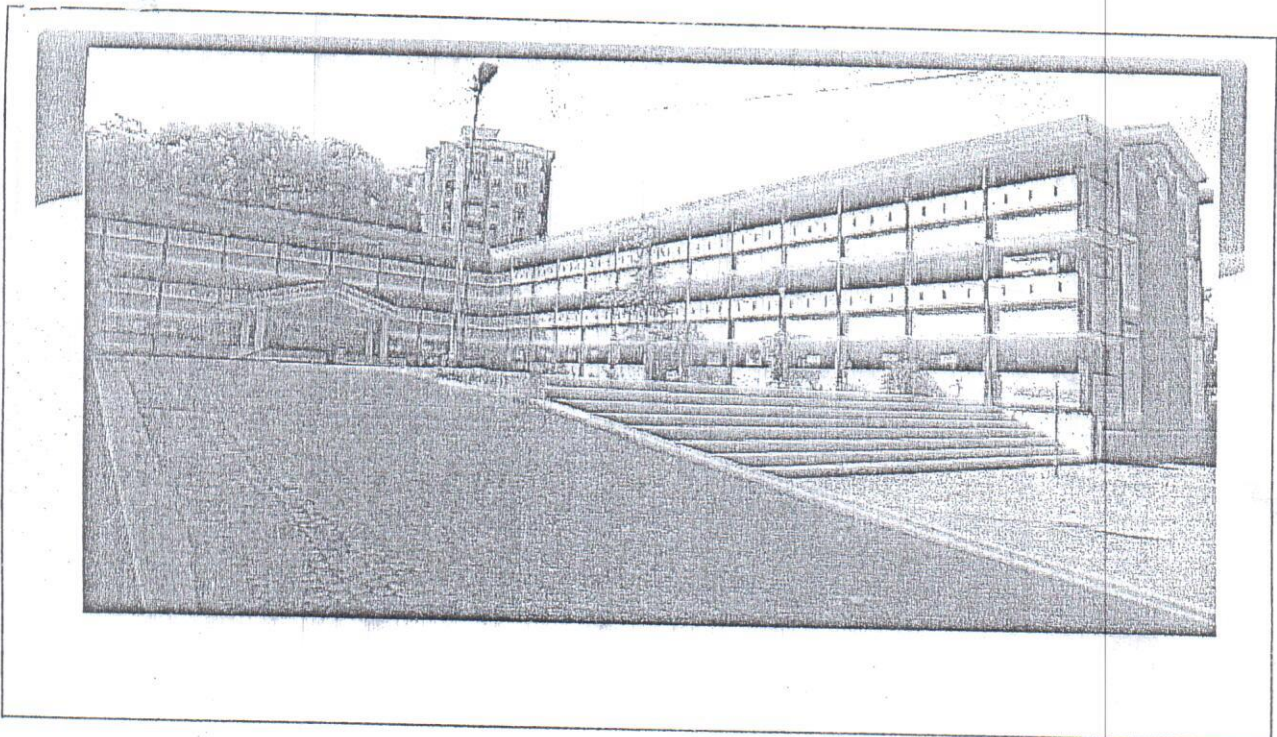

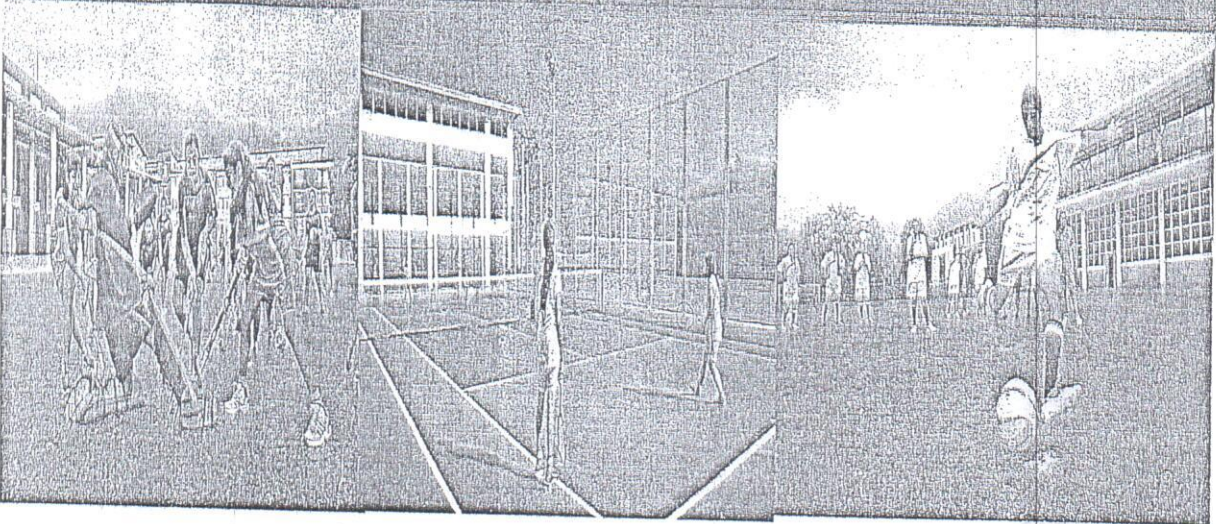

Selection Process:

Admission:

- 1) At most 50 students of the concerned Assembly Constituency will be enrolled in Class Nursery .
- 2) Child must have completed 4 years as on 31st of December.
- 3) Merit for selection shall be determined on the basis of Date of Birth as entered in the Birth Register of all concern Panchayats/Municipal Corporation in the particular constituency.

If Two or more than two Children are born on same date then their order of preference shall be decided in following manner:

- A) First preference will be given to the Child with name which appears first in the alphabetical order of their name (as per Hindi Alphabet of their name as appearing in the Birth register of the panchayat/ municipal council/ Municipal corporation.

Cont..

- B) If name of the applicants are common then name of their father shall be considered in alphabetical order for determining the merit of candidates.
- C) Even if the name of candidate's father are common then name of the mother shall be considered for determining the merit.

2) No candidate will eligible to admission in subsequent class who has not studied nursery class from that school.

3) There will be a provision for reservation of seats for SC and ST candidates in proportion to their population in the concerned constituency but not less than the national average.

5) Only candidates from the assembly constituency of the proposed residential school will be opened will be eligible to apply for admission in the school.

However, in the constituencies where the school is opened and is altered in delimitation at a later stage the old boundaries will be considered for the purpose of eligibility for admission. Separate criteria may be designed for constituencies like hard/tribal areas (Lahaul and Spiti/ Kinnaur/Bharmour/Churah etc.) keeping in view tough geographic conditions of the area.

**NAME OF WORK:- CONSTRUCTION OF MODEL SCHOOL AT Satyas , BLOCK Tissa
IN TEHSIL Churah DISTRICT CHAMBA (H.P.)**

Govt. of India has taken a decision to make Elementary Education of good quality which is, accessible and affordable to all students. The focus will not only be on universal enrolment but on quality improvement also. Keeping this policy initiative in view one such Model School at Satyas in backward block of Tissa in district Chamba is proposed to be established. The school will strive to provide quality education in an affordable manner to the students of this educationally backward area. The school will cater to the needs of a population of approx. 102900 belonging to Churah Contingency of Chamba district. The project aims to establish an infrastructure including components, the brief note/statement of proposal of which has been separately appended below:-

1. **Administrative and Teaching block (0.6818 hect.)**:- In order to bring in efficiency in administrative and teaching-learning process, this component seems to be very promising.
2. **Separate Hostels for Boys/Girls (0.4900 hect.)**:- To provide students with homely environment the provision of separate Hostels for boys and girls has been proposed.
3. **Play ground, Auditorium and Gymnasium (1.1300 hect.)**:- In order for students' over all physical and intellectual development, amusement, recreation etc. the provision of the following facilities has been proposed:
 - i) **Play ground (0.5000 Hect.)** as a place for all outdoor activities, games etc.
 - ii) **Auditorium (0.2700 Hect.)** as a ready and equipped venue for various activities viz. cultural, co-curricular activities, seminars, symposia, other ceremonies, functions etc.
 - iii) **Gymnasium (0.3600 Hect.)** for development of physical strength and endurance amongst students.
4. **Basic Amenities (0.5882 hect.)** - The other basic amenities have also been incorporated as per following:
 - i) **Approach road and foot (0.2200 Hect.)** for the institution to be equipped with barrier free access by road as well as on foot.
 - ii) **Canteen (0.1100 Hect.)** as a place for students and staff to have small feasts during their off study hours.
 - iii) **Vehicle (Parking-1 (0.1100 Hect.) and Parking-2 (0.0800 Hect.)** for the ease of maneuvering and parking of vehicles.
 - iv) **Library cum store (0.0682 Hect.)** as a space for self study to the students and staff as well as to keep their belongings.

Technical Details of Compensatory afforestation Scheme are as follows:-

(a) General Details: an area of 5.78 hec will be taken up for planting under compensatory afforestation scheme in Dhar Gallu DPF. The area will be protected by barbed wire fencing and a mixture of conifer and broad leaved species will be planted. 1100 plants will be planted per hectare.

(b) Spacement: 3.00 Mtr x 2.5Mtr.

(c) Species: Chil, Ban and other broad leaved.

(d) Plantation Method: Nursery grown one & half year above old plants (in Polythene bags as well as naked root) will be planted in 30x30x30 cm and 45x45x45 cm pits in the selected area. Bush cutting will be done in the infested area. The plantation will be maintained for subsequent 10 years in which beating up of failures will be done. The plantation will be rainfed.

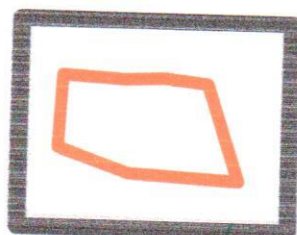

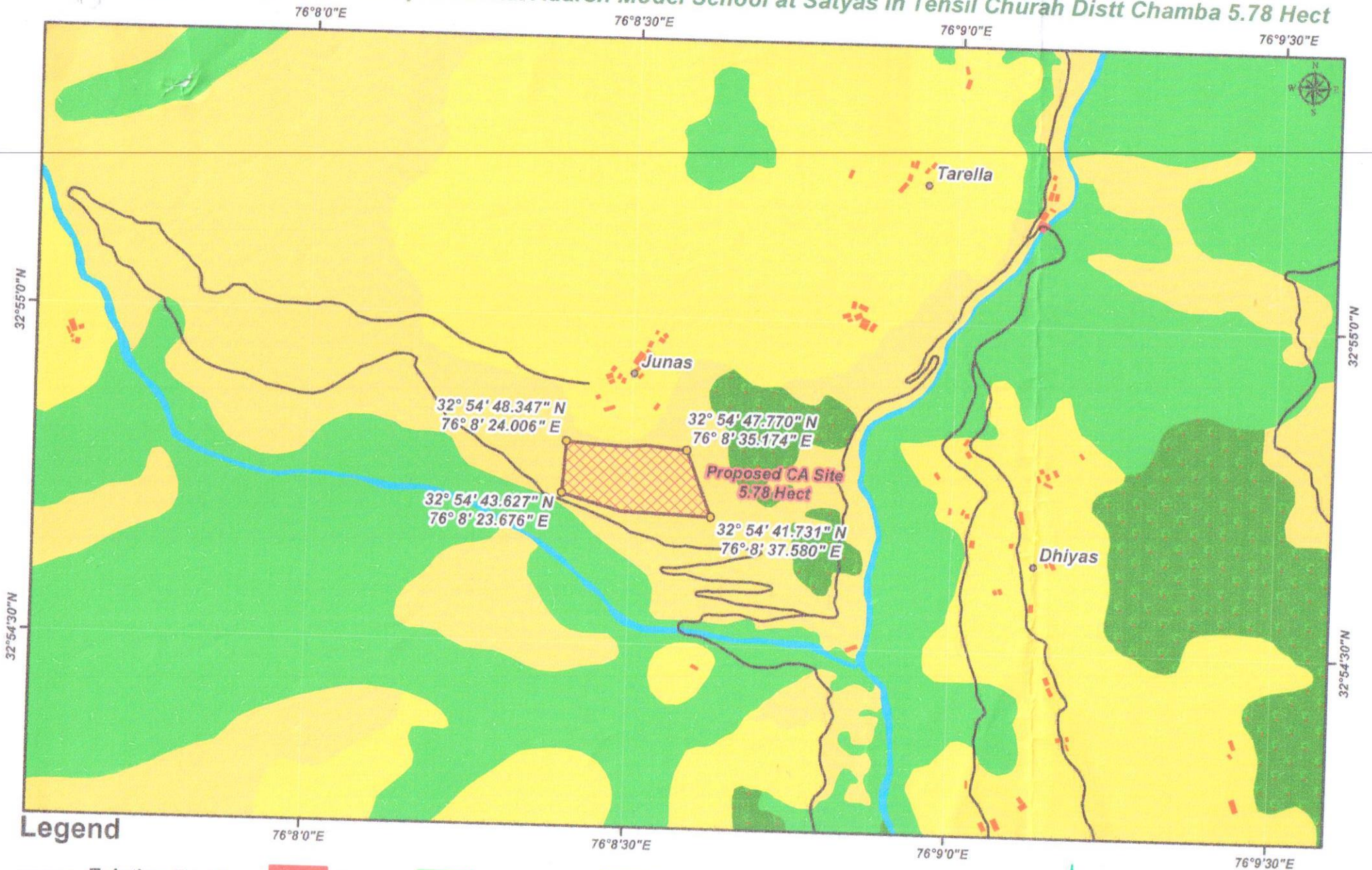
