In inviting a kind reference to the letter cited above on the captioned subject, this is to inform you that the User Agency i.e. General Manager, MCL, Lakhanpur Area has submitted the point wise compliance report on the observation raised by the Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC Act., O/o the PCCF & HoFF, Odisha, BBSR. Hence, the point wise compliance report duly complied by the User Agency is furnished below:

(i) A tabular statement indicating total area allotted by Ministry of Coal, area earmarked for Lakhanpur, Belpahar, Lilari Coal Blocks and area now proposed for integrated Lakhanpur-Belpahar-Lilari OCP should be furnished with area change matrix.

In compliance to the above, the total area allotted by Ministry is 4133.333ha as per approved Mining Plan, area earmarked for existing Lakhanpur OCP, Belpahar OCP & Lilari OCP. Now as per approved Mining Plan total Mining Lease area is 4399.246ha and Project area is 4742.877ha proposed for Integrated Lakhanpur-Belpahar-Lilari OCP. Copy of statement of approved Mining Plan enclosed. The details of tabular statement with area change matrix is furnished below.

As per letter No.3062/1F dt.25.08.2007 of the DFO, Sambalpur South Division(Now Sambalpur Division), 324.0 ha. of Compensatory Afforestation has already been raised in Baighara RF, & Tabla A & B RF under Sambalpur Division against the diversion of 162.20 ha. of forest land for Lilari OCP including safety zone.

Further, 466.86 ha. of Compensatory Afforestation has already been raised in Chandlidunguri RF under Sambalpur Division against the diversion of 233.43 ha. of forest for Lakhanpur OCP including safety zone.

In case of Belpahar OCP Rs.2,46,664/- towards the cost of 4.20 ha (one and half time in extent to the area 2.80 ha used for safety zone) deposited in Ac. No 344902010105428 of Union Bank of India, Sundarnagar Branch, New Delhi- 110003 on 30.12.2013 through RTGS mode by the User Agency(copy enclosed). Further, 4.20 ha. gap plantation has been raised with an expenditure of Rs.152250/- during the year 2016-17 in Ullap, PRF for 840 nos of seedlings by this Division.
