Sub: Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 – Proposal (FP/TN/Road/37291/2018) for diversion of 4.61 ha of forest land in Kesarkuli Reserved Forest and Thirumalvadi Reserved Land for formation of road from Seenkadu to Allakatu via Erimalai village in Dharmapuri Forest Division in Dharmapuri District in favour of the Block Development Officer BP, Pennagaram Union, Pennagaram, Dharmapuri District – EDS raised by Government of India – Revised proposal forwarding of - Regarding.

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I am directed to invite your attention to the references cited and to enclose a copy of the reference ninth cited wherein the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (HoFF) has furnished a revised proposal based on the observations made by the Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change,

Regional office in the reference eighth cited, for diversion of 4.61 ha of forest land in Kesarkuli Reserved Forest and Thirumalvadi Reserved Land for formation of road from Seenkadu to Allakatu via Erimalai village in Dharmapuri Forest Division.

2. The Government have examined the revised proposal of Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and decided to accept and forward the same to Regional office, Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forests and Climate Change and also to recommend the felling of 124 no's of spontaneous tress for the above said project subject to the following conditions:-

- i. The legal status of the diverted forest land remains unchanged.
- ii. The demarcation of the proposed forest land shall be carried out by the User Agency by erecting 4 feet high cement concrete pillars duly numbered at an interval of 20 meters at their cost.
- iii. The User Agency has to mutate and transfer 9.92ha of non-forest land indentified in SF No.692/6 of in No.18, Kammampatty Village of Nallampalli Taluk in Dharmapuri District to the Forest Department.
- iv. The User Agency has to pay the cost of Raising Compensatory Afforestation / Maintenance of plantation, protection of plantation etc., as fixed by the Forest Department and willingness to deposit additional amounts if any suggested as amended owing to the change in planting technique, enhancement in the FSR etc., demanded subsequently.
- v. The User Agency has to pay the Net Present Value of proposed forests diversion area which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India /Government of India.
- vi. The User Agency has to bear the additional amount of Net Present Value which will be fixed as per the guidelines of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India as fixed by Forest Department in future.
- vii. Amount of Compensatory afforestation scheme, Net Present Value of diverted forest area under the project shall be transferred/ deposited to CAMPA fund only through e-portal (<https://parivesh.nic.in/>)
- viii. The user agency has to obtain approval from the National Board for Wildlife under Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 for formation of road from Seenkadu village to Alakattu village through Erimalai village for the road passes through Kesarkuli Reserved Forest and Thirumalvadi Reserved Land.
- ix. The user agency has to pay the cost towards felling and transportation cost of 124 no's trees to be cut in the project area to the District Forest Officer, Dharmapuri Division for immediate execution of the felling of trees work after getting necessary permission for felling of trees.
- x. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- xi. The User Agency has to pay the cost towards annual lease rent for the forest area diversion period as fixed by the Forest Department at the time of sanction along with any escalation for the forest land to be diverted of the above project in future for the entire project period.
- xii. The total forest area utilized for the project shall not exceed 4.61 ha for with a length of 6384.0 m and width of 6.00m from Seenkadu to Erimalai and 5.00m width from Erimalai to Alakkattu.
- xiii. The forest land proposed to be diverted shall under no circumstances be transferred to any other agencies/department or person without prior approval of the State Government.

- xiv. Period of lease is twenty (20) years. The User Agency has to apply renewal proposal before one year of expiry of lease with the State Forest Department.

3. I am therefore to request you to obtain the concurrence of the competent authority and communicate the same to Government immediately.

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With reference to the Government letter 10<sup>th</sup> cited and EDS raised by the Government of India in parivesh portal on 29.07.2024, I wish to state the following.

1) As per the observations made by the Government of India, the user agency has revised the requirement of forest area for the project so as to reduce the number of trees to be felled in the project, which are spontaneous trees growth.

a) Total length of the road is 6384.0m and the road formation work is being proposed as follows

i) Reach-01 3166.50m length and 6.00m width and area of 18999.00 sq.m

ii) Reach-02 for 1699.50m length and 6.00m width and area of 10197.00 sq.m

iii) Reach-03 for 1518.50m length and 5.00m width and area of 7592.50 sq.m

iv) Add for curves 37 nos x 250 sq.m area = 9250 sq.m

Total area of 46038.50 sq.m or 4.61 ha.

b) Accordingly, the user agency has uploaded the revised justification report for the project, revised area requirement details, District Collector certificate under Forest Rights Act, 2006 in the Part-I of Form-A.

c) Kml file has been uploaded for 2.45 ha, 1.26 h and 0.90 ha area in three reach areas including the areas required for curves in the proposed road alignment path.

2) Based on the revised forest area required for the project, the user agency has modified the kml file of non-forest land to 9.92 ha in Kammampattyy village in Dharmapuri District. Revised proceeding of the District Collector on allotment of revised area for the project, revised Adangal register extract have been uploaded in the parivesh portal.

3) Based on the revision made the extent of forest area required for the project, the number of trees to be felled in the proposed road alignment reverified and marked on the trees for identification. There are cumulatively 124 numbers of trees to be felled. In that, there are 46 numbers of trees are presence from Seenkadu to Erimalai

(6m width) and there are 78nos of trees are presence from Erimalai to Alakkattu (5mtr width). These trees details were updated in additional information details section in form A of PART II in Parivesh 1.0.

4) The District Forest Officer, Dharmapuri Division has proposed revised Compensatory Afforestation over 20.00 Ha in the identified degraded forest area of Kavaramalai Extension Reserved Forest of Morappur Range in Dharmapuri Forest Division. The necessary documents such as CA land suitability certificate, Geo map, SOI map, CA Scheme estimates were updated in the additional information details section of Part-III of Form-A. This degraded forest area has bisons and spotted deers. Thus, necessary chain link fencing will be erected for protection purposes as well as to avoid Cattle and biotic disturbances. Also, for effective water supply Drip irrigation system is provided. For this purpose, the User agency has given necessary undertaking for payment of cost for Compensatory Afforestation Scheme as fixed by the forest department.

a) However, there is no option provided in Part-II of Form-A for uploading the kml file of alternate compensatory area identified for the project apart from the non-forest land identified by the user agency as compensatory land.

5) The User Agency has applied the online proposal seeking Wildlife clearance vide WL/TN/SRY/430594/2023, dated.24.05.2023. Now this proposal is under scrutiny with the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden, Chennai. The ESZ notification for CSWLS is not yet notified by the Government. Hence, the approval under District Committee need not be obtained.

6) The necessary site specific Wildlife Mitigation Plan has been prepared by the District Forest Officer based on the wildlife movement observed in the area. Elephants, Spotted deers, monkeys, Wildboar, etc., presence are noticed in the proposed road alignment lies in Kesarkuli Reserved Forest of Palacode Range. This Mitigation plan will be implemented based on the approval of the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests and Chief Wildlife Warden, Chennai.

7) Further, I wish to state that, the user agency has reported that, in Parivesh portal, area details already uploaded under Section A-1 viii, B2.1, B2.2 and C-i could not be edited and modified in Part-I of Form-A.

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a) Similarly, in Part-II of Form-A, under section, 1-iv, area details could not be modified.

8) The District Forest Officer, Dharmapuri Division has uploaded the revised site inspection report. Since revised recommendation of the proposal could not be uploaded in the recommendation section, revised recommendation of the proposal uploaded in the additional information details section.

a) Revised recommendation of the proposal could not be uploaded for the Conservator of Forests and Nodal Officer in the parivesh portal.

I request that the revised proposal furnished for diversion of 4.61 ha of forest land for formation of road from Seenkadu to Allakatu via Erimalai village in Dharmapuri Forest Division to a length of 6384m in favour of Block Development Officer BP, Pennagaram Union, Pennagaram, Dharmapuri District may be considered and approval of Government of India may be obtained.
