Subject Diversion of 0.486 hectare of forest land in favour of HPPWD for the construction of link road from Balhi to Chuwari Km 0/0 to 1/00 within the jurisdiction of Bilaspur Forest Division.

The point wise reply to the observations raised by you vide your letter quoted above is furnished as under:

1.	Total period for which the area proposed for diversion is not mentioned in Online Part-I	Total period for which the area proposed for diversion has been mentioned in Online Part-I as the area is required for ninety nine years.
2.	Short narrative of the project does not provide adequate information regarding the project in Online Part-I	Adequate information has been provided on line in Part-I as the 0.486 hect. of forest land is proposed to be diverted for the construction of Balhi to Chuwari road K.M.0/0 to 1/0.
3.	The village wise break-up is not provided in Online Part-I.	The village wise break-up has been provided online. It is apprised that the link road to village Chuwari bifurcate from Amarpur Hadsar Dhad Jamman Ghumarwin road at Sub-Village Balhi.The Sub village Balhiis not a Revenue Village rather the placed/ point from where the road commenced is known as Balhi which is sub-Village and not Revenue Village. The road will connect Reveneue Village Chuwari.
4.	The name of the components are wrongly mentioned in online Part-I, Para B2.4.	There is only one component i.e. diversion of Forest land for the construction of road, as the forest land is not required for dumpingof muck
5.	The employment details are not filled correctly. The State may review the same and provide correct/appropriate date.	The employment detail has now been filled properly, as 8914 mandays will be generated due to construction of road.
6.	The geo-referenced map provided in hard copy of the proposal if area proposed for diversion is not found uploaded at Para C (iv) in Online part-I.	The geo-referenced map has been up-loaded on line Part-C (iv) in Part-I.
7.	The date of FRA certificate issued is not mentioned in the certificate.	The date has been clearly mentioned in proceeding of Distt. Level Committee. i.e. 13.08.2014.
8.	The density of the area	The density of the area proposed for

	proposed for diversion is mentioned 0.4 in online Part-II appears inappropriate. The State Govt. may review the same because 28 trees/ ha does not account for 0.4 density.	diversion is mentioned 3.86 in online Part-II.
9.	The area is vulnerable for soil erosion as per information provided in Part-II online. The State Govt. may provide detail of protective measures taken and provision of fund for this purpose.	As per Part-II Online as well as in hard copy No danger due to erosion in the area as such the soli starta is rocky.
10.	Original copy of Part-III may be provided to this office.	The original copy of Part -III is to be provided by the CF office.
11.	The State Govt. may provide Penal CA Scheme for area 5 times of the area broken i.e. $0.25 \times 5 = 1.25$ ha and provide KML file geo-referenced map and suitability certificate for Penal CA area.	The Penal CA scheme for 5 times of the area broken i.e. $0.30 \times 5 = 1.50$ hac. has been prepared and uploaded online. The above penal CA will be carried out in DPF Baryans which has all ready been proposed for CA in above proposal. The KML files, Geo-referenced map and land suitability certificate have already been placed in proposal folder and also uploaded online.
