In inviting reference to Letter No.5-ORB537/2022-BHU dated 30.11.2022 of Dy. Inspector General of Forests (C), GoI, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar on the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that the User Agency has submitted the details of justification for locating the project road in the forest area through RCCF, Bhubaneswar Circle (Copy enclosed).

This proposal is for construction of approach road from old Industrial Estate at Gothapatna to newly allotted Industrial Estate of area 79.394 Ac. at Village Gothapatna under Bhubaneswar Tahasil. The User Agency has reported that all the surrounding area are of Private Lands where number of housing colonies, including multi storied buildings and natural streams are there for which the approach road was aligned through Revenue Forest land. The User Agency has also examined three alternate route A, B & C at different points of newly allotted area and rejected alignment A & C for longer length, high density of trees and good quality of soil for cultivable land and the reason seems to be justified enough.

In view of the above, the project proposal submitted by this office may be considered and in principle approval may be accorded under Section-2 (ii) of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980.



In the industrial area of Gothapatana many famous technical institutes like IIIT, BIMT, IMI, NALCO Quality Control center etc. have been established. To meet the increasing demand of small and medium enterprisers around Bhubaneswar city, Government vide O.O-No.5564/ Dt.29.03.2016 of Collector & D.M, Khordha has allotted Ac.79.394dc of non-forest land in Gothapatana village under Bhubaneswar tehasil for establishment of a new industrial area. But due to lack of an approach road from Gothapatana, this patch of Ac.79.394dc of sanctioned by Govt. for industrial area has remained unutilized from 2016 and allottees are unable to establish their units. So it was proposed to construct an approach road to this new industrial area from Gothapatana which will serve as as a link between two industrial areas in Gothapatana.

Since all the surrounding areas are private lands where numerous housing colonies including multi storied buildings have come up and natural drains are available at many places, this approach road is proposed to be aligned through the patch of revenue forest land (of area Ac.177.420 dc) separating these two patches of industrial areas in Gothapatna mauza.

Three alternative roads (A,B,C) were examined and the plan "B" was found most suitable.

Plan A - This stretch of road is proposed to emerge from the end point of existing road in existing Industrial area in Gothapatana in Plot no.952 and to connect to Plot no.144 of Gothapatna on western end measures around 725 mtrs. . This stretch of land has a good soil quality and has growth of plants having plantation of Acacia, Sana Chakunda, Simaruba and Nim etc.

Plan- B- This stretch of road is proposed to emerge from the end point of existing road in existing Industrial area in Gothapatana in plot no.952 and to connect to Plot no.144 of Gothapatna at the center measures 582.99 mt. This patch of land is of hard soil, murram to stony with exposed rocks and laterite pan at places and there low density of tree growth of Acacia, Chakunda, Simaruba and cashew nut plants.

Plan-C- This stretch of road is proposed to emerge from the end point of existing road in existing Industrial area in Gothapatana in Plot no.952 and to connect to Plot no.149 of Gothapatna at the center. The length of the proposed segment is around 600 mtr. with a relatively high density of crop of old plantation of Acacia, Chakunda, Nim, Karanja and Simaruba etc. with promising growth. The soil quality is loamy to red with good humus.

In view of the longer length of road, higher density of trees and good quality of soil, Plan A and plan "C" were rejected for construction of proposed road and the plan "B" which is of lesser stretch of 582.99 mt having laterite pan and exposed rock with thinner density of crop with stunted growth due to bad site condition was selected for the purpose of road.
