User Agency has violated the provision of forest conservation Act 1980 as the non forestry work has already been done on the propose forest land without taking prior approval of Govt. of India, it is recommended that out of total 5.6322 ha of forest land applied for diversion, 4.473 ha can be treated as regularization and rest 1.1592 ha. of forest land can be treated as fresh forest diversion. The details regarding land schedule for regularization and fresh diversion is attached herewith as Annexure VI Penal Compensatory afforestation (2 times) and penal NPV (2 times) can be charged from the User Agency for said violation.
