1	In the part-II for Form-A and site inspection and recommendation of the project proposal it has been reported that 15 numbers of standing tress are to be felled in the project area. However the status of tress whether the standing trees are of planted or spontaneous tress has not been reported.	15 numbers standing trees are spontaneous growth.

2.	For the diversion of 0.8169 Ha of forest area, compensatory afforestation has been proposed by planting of 1634 number of tress in 1.633 Ha degraded forest area in Salur RF. In the compensatory afforestation scheme, digging 1784 Nos of staggered trench to the plants has been proposed to an amount of Rs.12,30,675/- and water harvesting trench along the boundary of Salur RF to a length of 300 meter has been proposed to an amount of Rs.97,884/- Justification for providing above work in the CA scheme has not been furnished.	
3.	Compensatory afforestation scheme estimate should contain the essential items required for the successful planting activity. Water harvesting structures if any required in the degraded forest area may be proposed in other schemes.	Only essential items required for successful planting activity have been included.
4	In this proposal, compensatory afforestation in double the extent of degraded forest area has been proposed as per the guidelines of 2.5(i) g of Chapter 2 of Forest Conservation Act 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules 2002 issued during March 2019. In addition to the above, planting of ten times of trees to be felled for the project has also been proposed as per the guidelines issued by the Government of India under 2.6 of Chapter 2 of Forest Conservation Act 1980 and Forest Conservation Act 1980 and Forest Conservation Rules 2002 issued during March 2019.
