Whether the proposed diversion of forest area is an fresh diversion or work proposed in already diverted / right of way road area	The proposed diversion of Pulikoradu reserved forest area is not an fresh diversion. It falls in the area already diverted under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980 to MEPZ – SEZ vide G.O.(Ms)No.73 Environment and Forests (FR.10) Department dated 23.05.2013 for utilization of road to a length of 500 mtr in Pulikoradu RF.
