Recommendation of the Office for Project

Name of Project: BATTISA NALLAH MINOR IRRIGATION PROJECT

Proposal No.: FP/RJ/IRRIG/22443/2016

Battisanalla Minor Irrigation project envisages to tame the non utilized runoff for providing Irrigation facilities to many downstream villages and drinking water facilities to several human habitations including two towns. This project if implemented would submerge 91.202 Ha of forest land in Aburoad range of Sirohi Forest Division. This project may also affect about 84 families that reside in this area. Considering the cost benefit analysis of the project and as highlighted in the site inspection report, forest clearance for this project may be granted with certain condition enumerated below:-

- 1) The construction including any blasting activity should not be done in night and must be done in consultation to local forest officers.
- 2) Proper rehabilitation and resettlement must be done to all affected families, preferably "Land against Land" be observed.
- 3) No open water channels should be constructed in forest area for water transportation for any purpose.
- 4) No vegetation should be cleared than actual construction site, and whatsoever forest produce is removed must be transported by user agency to Department's Swaroopganj Depot for further disposal.
- 5) One watch tower and one Guard chouki must be constructed in the forest areas adjacent to project site for better monitoring of area from wildlife management and forest protection point of views. The cost of it must be borne by user agency out of this project.
- 6) User agency must abide by any further instructions that are disseminated by local forest officers during project implementation that are supposed necessary from forest management point of view.

Therefore, considering the large benefits likely to accrue from this project, the project is proposed for acceptance with suggestion that local Forest officers monitor the area continuously during implementing the project so as to ensure minimal damage to the local ecosystem.
