Kind attention is invited to the subject and reference cited. Kerala Water Authority Perumbavoor Project Director had submitted a proposal in Parivesh portal (FP/KL/Pipe line/41944/2019) for the augmentation of water supply scheme in Angamaly Constituency. The proposed project passes through the areas of Malayattoor Forest Division and Nature Study Centre, Kalady division. The requested area for the above work under this division was .46956 Ha. and my predecessor had recommended for the conversion of .46956 Ha of forest land. Vide reference 2, the user agency has informed that they have mistakenly included some non forest area in the proposal and submitted new list. Range forest officer Research Range Kodanad submitted the report vide reference 3. As per the report, The total length of the pipe line will be 3913m and the Forest area required is 0.313040 Ha under this division. Because, the road side area from Kadappara up to Chelachuvadu area is also required by the user agency. Here also no felling of trees is required. The above details are submitted for kind necessary action.
