Sub: Diversion of 594.618 ha (292.289 ha in Nayagarh Forest Division and 302.329 ha in Boudh Forest Division) of forest land in connection with Khurda- Bolangir New BG Rail Link Project 112 Km to 180 Km under Nayagarh and Boudh Forest Division by East Coast Railway.

Sir,

In reference to the above mentioned subject, this is to inform that the Government of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar had deferred the proposal in the REC meeting held on 20<sup>th</sup> September, 2022 with certain observations with a request to furnish compliances for non-forestry use of 594.618 ha of forest land in favour of East Coast Railway in Boudh & Nayagarh District. The user agency has furnished the compliances and subsequently DFO of DFO, Boudh & DFO, Nayagarh have submitted the point wise compliances after due examination and accordingly, I am to submit the information as below on the observation of REC:-

Observation (1):- As the proposed railway line is in the elephant impact zone and elephant corridor, so elephant overpasses, underpasses and viaducts at appropriate positions as identified by the local Divisional Forest Officer should be constructed, fencing of the railway line towards the sanctuary side should be done so that elephant will not enter the track and will use the under passes and overpasses.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the DFO, Boudh Division & Nayagarh Division have reported that the user agency has furnished an undertaking that as the proposed railway line is in the elephant impact zone and elephant corridor, elephant overpasses, underpasses and viaducts at appropriate positions as identified by the local Divisional Forest Officer would be constructed, fencing of the railway line towards the sanctuary side shall be done so that elephant will not enter the track and will use the under passes and overpasses, which are enclosed as Annexure-I & I (a).

Observation (2):- Speed of the train should be less than 20 Km per hour in the stretch and Forest Department/ Railway Authority should regularly inform each other regarding the movement of elephant so that the train can be stopped without harm to elephants as and when required.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the DFO, Boudh & Nayagarh Division have reported that the condition has already been incorporated in the approved Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan duly approved by PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha vide his Memo No. 9733 dated 28.10.2022, which is enclosed as Annexure-II.

Observation (3):- A Comprehensive Wildlife Management Plan should be prepared addressing all the issues raised during the site inspection/REC meeting, not only for safety of elephant but also for all the wildlife found in the locality duly approved by CWLW.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, the DFO, Boudh & Nayagarh Division have reported that the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan has been prepared and approved by the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha Bhubaneswar addressing the safety of elephant, other Wildlife and habitat management vide his letter No. 8564 dated 22.09.2022 (Copy enclosed as Annexure-III) with additional condition i.e. speed of the train should be less than 20 Km per hour in the stretch and Forest Department/ Railway Authority should regularly inform each other regarding the movement of elephant, so that the train can be stopped without harm to elephants as and when required has been incorporated in the approved Wildlife Conservation Plan as intimated vide his Memo No. 9732 dated 28.10.2022 of the PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha.

Observation (4):- From the DSS as well as the site inspection report, it appears that the proposed railway line is very close to the boundary of Baisipalli Wildlife Sanctuary (From Buguda Colony to Baniguchha, approximately 15 KM). As per the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India order in IA No. 1000 of 2003 dated 03.06.2022, the Railway Authority should realign the above stretch keeping in view the minimum distance 1 KM from the boundary of Baisipalli Wildlife Sanctuary.

Compliance:- In compliance to the above, considering the representation of the project proponent dated 18.11.2022 (Copy enclosed as Annexure-IV) the PCCF & HoFF has passed an order that this project is an ongoing project and construction of railway line is not one of the prohibited activities in the ESZ, as per the 9<sup>th</sup> February, 2011 guideline issued by Ministry of Environment & Forest, Government of India and more ever this phase of the Railway line project, i.e. 112 Km to 180 Km

stretch is permitted as per Para 44 (e) of the judgment of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 03.06.2022 in IA No. 1000 of 2003 subject to forest clearance as it involves forest land (Copy enclosed as Annexure-V).

The DFO, Navagarh Division in her compliance has further mentioned that, the railway line has been realigned after the objection from DFO, Navagarh and is present within 1 Km (300 mt) from the boundary of Baisipalli Sanctuary. Further, shifting is not practically feasible as it will pass through the middle of the Brutanaga reservoir for which Stage-I approval has been accorded vide F. no. 8-23/2010-FC of Government of India, MoEF & CC (FC Division) dated 31st August, 2010.

It is therefore requested to consider the above information and process the diversion proposal at the earliest.

Approval of Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan to implement mitigation measures has been communicated to you vide this office Letter No.8564 dt. 22.09. 2022. Subsequently, MoEF&CC., IRO, Bhubaneswar vide Letter No.5-ORA528/2022-BHU dt 20.09.2022 has communicated the observations of the REC in the meeting held on 15.09.2022. As per Observation at Sl. No.2, the following condition is added in the SSWLCP, which should be adhered to scrupulously.

"Speed of the train should be less than 20 Km per hour in the stretch and Forest Department! Railway Authority should regularly inform each other regarding the movement of elephant so that the train can be stopped without harm to elephants as and when required."

The aforesaid condition is in addition to the stipulation on related protection measures already incorporated in the approved plan cited supra.

It is to intimate that you have to implement mitigation measures as per approved Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan.I am directed to convey the approval of PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha for the Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan for the above project at financial outlay of ₹2892.185 lakh (Rupes twenty-eight crore ninety-two lakh eighteen thousand five hundred) only for the following activities:

(a)	In project impact area in Nayagarh Division	₹921.833 lakh
(b)	In project impact area in Mahanadi WL Division	₹329.647 lakh
(c)	In project impact area in Phulbani Division	₹289.003 lakh
(d)	In project impact area in Boudh Division	₹1351.702 lakh
Total:		₹2892.185 lakh

- 3. Activities in the project area will be executed by the project proponent under the guidance of DFO, Nayagarh/ Boudh Division, as the case may be. A sum of ₹2892.185 lakh shall be deposited in State CAMPA fund only through e-portal (https://parivesh.nic.in/) for implementation of various activities within the project impact area by the Forest Department through concerned DFOs.
- 4. The following conditions may be noted for future compliance.
  - a. If there would be need for Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan after expiry of the present plan period, the User agency will have to submit another such plan at least one year before the expiry of the existing Conservation Plan and deposit the amount upon its approval. In case of delay, it will be dealt as per law for violations of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and Environment (Protection) Act, 1986.



b. The User agency has to give an undertaking to bear the differential cost in case of enhancement of wage rate during implementation of this plan.



Sir,

In reference to above subject matter and letter under references Khurda Road – Bolangir New B.G.Rail Link project was sanctioned in 1994-95 (*Annexure-I*) and the work is in progress. It covers length of 289 Km passing through districts of *Puri, Khurda, Nayagarh, Boudh, Subarnpur & Bolangir*.

Detailed Estimate was sanctioned in phases i.e, between *Km. 0-36Km in Phase-II, Km.36-Km.112 in Phase-II, Km.112-240 in Ph-III & Km.240-289 in Ph-IV.* Accordingly land acquisition proposal and Forest diversion proposal was processed in 5 phases. *(Annexure-II)* 

- (i) Km. 0 Km.36, for which Stage-I and Stage –II clearance obtained in the year 2008 and the section commissioned. (Annexure-III)
- (ii) Km. 36 Km. 112, for which Stage-I and Stage –II clearance obtained in the year 2020 and commissioned upto Km 91 and for rest of the patch work is in progress. (*Annexure-IV*)



- (iii) Km. 180 Km. 238 Stage-I clearance working permission was obtained on 09.02.2021 and the construction is in progress. (Annexure-V)
- (iv) Km 238-289 Stage-I clearance working permission was obtained on 20.08.2019. Km. 263 to 289 commissioned and the construction work is in progress in rest of the patches. (Annexure-VI)
- (v) Km-112-180, Stage I clearance is under process.

In this connection, it is to mention that State Govt. is providing land free of Cost from Km. 112-289 and also sharing 50% construction cost of the above patch. Forest Clearance proposal between Km. 112-180 was processed and forwarded to MoEF by State Govt. after complying all the observations of State Forest Department. It is also mentioned that Site Specific Wildlife Conservation Plan (SSWLCP) has already been approved by PCCF (WL) & CWLW, Odisha, vide letter No.8564/CWLW-FDWC-FD-0121-2021 dt.22.09.2022 (Annexure-VII). However, the proposal was returned on 20.09.2022 by MoEF based on discussion in the Regional Empower Committee with certain observations, which would be complied with except item No.-4, where it is advised to realign keeping in view the minimum distance of 1 Km from Baisipalli Wildlife Sanctuary.

Khurda Road – Bolangir New BG Rail line project is a socio-economy project sanctioned by Railway Board in1994-95. Final Location survey was undertaken in the year 1994-95. The line covers a length 289 Km connecting Khurda Road Station on Howrah – Chennai Main line to Bolangir situated on Titilagarh – Sambalpur – Jharsuguda branch line. The line falls entirely in the State of Odisha and traverses through Six District of State Viz. Puri, Khurda, Nayagarh, Boudh, Subarnapur and Bolangir. After completion of project it will connect the coastal Odisha with Western Odisha leading to commercial and cultural integration of both parts. Moreover, it will reduce the distance to New Delhi, Mumbai and western India by 140 Km. from Bhubaneswar and Puri in the State Capital and cultural capital of Odisha respectively.

In the initial proposal this line was passing through the Baisipalli Wildlife Sanctuary adjacent to NH from Km 128 to Km 132 (Map enclosed as *Annexure-VIII*). DFO wildlife Division, Nayagarh has objected this alignment, which was passing through the Baisipalli Wildlife Sanctuary and it was decided to change the alignment and to take the alignment out of sanctuary area as far as possible. Accordingly the new alignment was planned. However during fixing of alignment it is found that a new dam project on Bhrutang River is coming up and the alignment was coming inside the reservoir area of proposed dam. Water Resource Department has objected to carry the alignment inside the reservoir and after a detailed discussion it was finalized to carry the alignment in the fringe area of the reservoir by providing viaduct. After detailed survey the present alignment was finalized considering the sanctuary area on one side and Bhrutang reservoir on the other side in the year 2018. At present shifting of alignment is not possible and this may lead to again entering inside the reservoir.



- The work is in progress from both side i.e. from Km.0-112 from Khurda end (out of which Km.0 to Km.91 commissioned) and Km.180-289 from Bolangir end (out of which Km.263.5 to Km.289 commissioned).
- Estimate for Km.112 to Km.180 was sanctioned in June'2016.
- Activities like finalization of 'L' section, survey, land boundary demarcation have already been completed and respective Land Schedule for Forest, Govt. & Private land were submitted to Govt. of Odisha on 02.11.2018 for processing to acquire as per LA act-2013.
- At present entire process of Land acquisition has been completed and the entire private land/Govt. Land in this patch has already been acquired after completing the process of disbursement of private land compensation to the land losers.
- The present railway alignment has been finalized taking into consideration boundary of Baisapali Sanctutary on one side and future Bhrutang irrigation reserver on the other side with rulling gradient of 1 in 150.
- The present route & L-Section has been designed, balancing the cutting, filling areas and minimizing the use of reserve/dense forest areas.
- Shifting of railway alignment may also lead to restrict the ruling gradient
  1 in 150 as the new alignment will have to cross the hilly terrain &
  Bhurtanga Reservoir. Providing steeper gradient will lead to train
  operation problem.
- Shifting of railway alignment to the other side of the Bhurtang River will
  also shift the Buguda Railway Station to the other side of the river and it
  will fall inside future Bhrutang Irrigation Project. The distance to Buguda
  Railway Station will increase for the rail passengers/nearby villagers and
  the river has to be crossed and it will be difficult for access to the local
  people. The very purpose of KUR BLGR Railway line project is to
  connect the unconnected hinterland of Odisha with the Major cities will be
  defeated.

From the above paragraphs, it is crystal clear that the construction of the project is in advance stage of progress & already been re-aligned in between Km.122-130 to avoid the Baisiapalli wildlife sanctuary & Brutanga irrigation project in Buguda -Baniguchha section in Nayagarh district.

So, at this juncture, further change in alignment of the Railway line in between Buguda –Baniguchha section is not feasible. Moreover, shifting of Railway alignment towards the south side of the Baisipalli Sanctuary zone will enter inside the Brutanga Irrigation Reservoir which has already been objected by the Water Resources Deptt, Govt. of Odisha.

Vide letter under reference (2) cited above DIG (WL), MoEF (WL Division), NDLS has issued guide lines on dt.09.02.2011(Annexure-IX) for declaration of Ec-Sensitive zones around National Parks & wildlife sanctuaries. As per Annexure - 1 0 listed which are divided are lines, activities this quide regulated/prohibited/permitted categories in Eco-Sensitive areas while some activities could be allowed in all eco-sensitive zones. In the broad list of activities construction of new Railway line is not a part. Therefore, the construction activity of KUR-BLGR new BG rail link project is permissible as per the guide lines of MoEF (WL), NDLS.

In the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment, dated 03.06.2022 (Annexure-X), Clause 44(e), it is also mentioned that "In the event of any activity is already being under taken within one km or extended buffer zone (ESZ), as the case may be, of any wildlife sanctuary or national park which does not come within the ambit of prohibited activities as per the 9<sup>th</sup> February 2011 Guidelines, such activities may continue with permission of Principal Chief Conservator of Forest of each State or Union Territory and the person responsible for such activities in such a situation shall obtain necessary permission within a period of six months. Such permission shall be given once the Principal Chief Conservator of Forest is satisfied that the activities concerned do not come within the prohibited list and were continuing prior to passing of this order in a legitimate manner. No new permanent structure shall be permitted to come up for whatsoever purpose within the ESZ".

In view of the facts stated above and in overwhelming public interest, it is requested to look in to the matter & necessary Stage-I Clearance and working permission may be accorded in reference to the Hon'ble Supreme Court judgment, dated 03.06.2022, Clause 44(e) to continue the construction activities in Railway Km.112 to180 of KUR-BLGR new BG rail link for early completion of the project.

"Since, this project is an ongoing project, and construction of Railway line is not one of the prohibited activities, as per the 9<sup>th</sup> Feb, 2011 Guidelines, this phase of the Railway line project i.e. 112 Km to 180 Km stretch, is permitted, as per Para 44(e) of the Judgement of Hon'ble Supreme Court of India dated 03.06.2022, subject to obtaining F.C clearance, as it involves forest land."

Hence, it is requested to furnish compliance to the observations of REC dated 15.09.2022 immediately for transmitting the same to Govt. of India, MoEF & CC, IRO, Bhubaneswar for further course of action.
