In response, the reply to the query raised by the Government of Karnataka is furnished by the User Agency i.e., M/s Kirloskar Ferrous Industries Limited, the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Ballari Division and the Conservator of Forests, Ballari Circle Vide Ref (3), (4) and (5) to this office as below.

M/s JSW will utilize its dedicated closed pipe conveyor to transport material to their Integrated Steel Plant in Tornagallu. The same railway siding is proposed for our long-term benefits."

"The proposed approach road towards Ranjithpura village, for which Stage-II approval has been granted, passes through patta land owned by M/s. BMM (erstwhile lessee). BMM has set up a manufacturing unit in the land and hence

However, we require flexibility of using both Road and Rail movement of the goods considering our Koppal Plant and Hiriyur Plant. It may be noted that Hiriyur plant do not have railway siding facility. Hence, we have put forward an alternative proposal, which is more viable than the already Stage-II approved approach road on a longer run"
