

SITE INSPECTION REPORT BELOW THE RANK OF DCF(For the forest land to be diverted under FCA)

A proposal has been received by this office from Ghaziabad Development Authority Ghaziabad for diversion under (FCA- 1980) of 0.2107 Ha. of forestland non-forestry purpose. The project envisages the use of forestland for the construction of Metro Rail. The site inspection of the land involved in the proposal has done by me on dated 21/2/2014. On inspection of the site. It is found that land required by the user agency is a RF/un-classed/ Protect forest measuring 0.2107 Hac.

The requirement of forest land as proposed by the user agency in col. 2 part- I is unavoidable and is barest minimum required for the project.


