Subject: Proposed Protected forest land to be diverted for 4- Lane widening and strengthening of Bilrayan - Panwari Road (SH-21) From Ch. No. 399.60 to 427.00 km, (Chikasi to Rath), in Forest Division: Hamirpur, District: Hamirpur (Uttar Pradesh). **Proposal No. :** FP/UP/Road/41235/2019.

In reference to **letter no. 8B/UP/06/38/2020/FC/673**; Ministry of Environment Forest & Climate Change Regional Office (Central Region), **dated 15.06.2020**; replies of EDS are as follows:

1	Approval of the project from the competent authority has to be submitted.	Project approval letter has been attached.
2	No objection certificates of concerned department need to be submitted.	In this project, proposed land is under ownership of the same PWD department who is applying this proposal. Therefore, No objection certificate of concerned department is not applicable to this project.
3	Land schedule of the project needs to be submitted.	Land schedule of the Proposed Project has been attached.
4	Muck disposal plan approved by the DFO has to be submitted.	Muck Disposal plan approved by the DFO has been attached.
5	FRA certificate is without seal of DM.	Original FRA certificate with seal of DM has has been attached with the Proposal.
6	It is not clear that how many trees are proposed to be felled. In the cost benefit analysis number of trees proposed to be felled is mentioned as 2684 and no. of trees to be planted as per CA is mentioned as 5368. This needs clarification.	Corrected Cost benefit analysis (with total no. of trees proposed to be felled as 2611) has been attached with the proposal.

7	As per Google Earth Imageries proposed land to be diverted is falling in habitation area.	In this project, widening is proposed within boundary of Right of way of PWD road. Habitation area visible in Google Earth image is encroachment.
8	Demarcation of CA land patches on SOI toposheet is not in standard format. (Shape of CA land pattern on SOI toposheet and Geo reference map is not matching).	CA land shape as shown in Digital Geo referenced map is at scale of 1:10000. However, CA patches marked on SOI toposheet is at scale of 1:50000. So, due to this scale difference there might be any mismatching.
9	Agriculture pattern is seen on CA land patches. (Khangran-I, Khangran-II and Chandaut forest block).	Agriculture pattern visible in CA land patches is encroachment of reserved forest land in past. At present forest land proposed for CA plantation is free from any encroachment.
