Forest land in Hattikeri Village Sy No,10/A1A1A Belekeri Hobali, Ankola Taluk Uttar Kannada District, Karwar Division for for establishing Toll plaza with amenities (shifting from existing location at CH.117+900 to CH.131+200) in Goa-Karnataka Border and Kundapur Section of NH-66 Project Seabird (Primary User Agency) in favour of Project Director, National Highways Authority of India (NHAI) project Implementation Unit (PIU), Mangalore (Secondary User Agency) Karwar subject to the following conditions vide their letter cited at reference (1). 4)	As reported by the DFO violation has been taken place, in this regard the State Government is requested to kindly provide the action taken report, if any.	:	The construction of toll plaza was carried out as per the working permission issued by the National Highway Authority of India and project Seabird authority. The forest area was earlier diverted to Project Seabird. During construction, forest field officials, informed that, this was 2.469 ha. of forest land diverted to Project Seabird. By the time inadvertently the construction was started. The mistake was not intentional and it was taken up as per the alignment. Due to the non identification of forest land, private land and Project Seabird area the construction work was started. Hence, Forest Department informed National Highway Authority of India to submit a re-diversion proposal to Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change.
5)	The State Government shall provide the copy of the lease transfer from Ministry of Defence to NHAI.		The MOU between Ministry of Defence and National Highway Authority of India is enclosed.

Hence, Forest Department directed the National Highway Authority of India to move the rediversion proposal.
