उपर्युक्त विषय एवं प्रसंग के सन्दर्भ में सूचित करना है कि भारत सरकार द्वारा विषयक परियोजना पर भारत सरकार, पर्यावरण, वन एवं जलवायु परिवर्तन मंत्रालय, न्यू दिल्ली द्वारा चौदह बिन्दुओं पर पृच्छा की गई थी, जिसका अनुपालन प्रतिवेदन प्रयोक्ता अभिकरण ने अपने पत्रांक PO/Amrapali OC/Forest/Compliance/2023-24/514 दिनांक 06.06.2023 द्वारा आठ प्रतियों में इस कार्यालय में समर्पित किये हैं। समर्पित अनुपालन प्रतिवेदन की स्थिति निम्नवत है—


