Please refer to above letter on the subject. In this connection, it is to inform you that this is the proposal for renewal of forest clearance for diversion of 7.111 ha of forestland for oil drilling location at "KUP" & "KUL" which was accorded by the then Ministry of Environment & Forests, Gol vide No. 8-556/89-FC dtd. 08/07/1991 in favour of Oil India Limited (*Annexure-I*). All stipulated conditions of forest clearance have been complied including transfer of fund to an amount of Rs.2.03.725/- against CA cost by the User Agency (*Annexure-II*).

Further, the State Government of Arunachal Pradesh, vide letter No. DGM/ML/OIL/77/96(Pt-II)/378-89 dated 4th May'2018 has re-granted Petroleum Mining lease (PML) for Ningru Block over an area of 427.058 Sq. Km under Rule 5(I) (ii) of the Petroleum & Natural Gas Rules, 1959 for a period of 20 years from the effective date i.e. 27.11.2003 subject to certain terms and conditions mentioned therein. The above diverted area of 7.111 ha falls within Ningru PML which was re-granted for 20 years i.e upto 26/11/2023 and co-terminus with each other under Guidelines 7.3(iii) of guidelines issued under Forest (Conservation) Act 1980. Hence, renewal for diversion of 7.111 ha of forestland for oil drilling location "KUP" & "KUL" under Ningru Petroleum Mining Lease (PML) is required now. The information/documents for fresh diversion of forestland if submitted earlier are inadvertently and inconvenience as caused is regreatted.

The issues raised in the meeting by the public of the nearby project areas regarding employment, development, pollution control, health care facilities and CSR activities. In response to the issues raised by the Public in the meeting, the details reflected in the minutes at <i>Annexure-X(B)</i> . Further, OIL has sanctioned Rs.4.25 crores for repairing and construction of road in the areas of Changlang and Namsai District. It was also suggested that OIL should take remarable project like water supply in the area. In this regards, a few of the CSR activities done by OIL is attached at <i>Annexure-X(C)</i> .

It is also pointed out here that the above is monitored by the PMO regularly which is one of the ambitious scheme for development of the country as well as concerned state.

It is therefore, requested to kindly convey the approval of the Ministry of Environment . Forests & Climate Change, Government of India for renewal of forest clearance for diversion of 7.11 ha of forestland for oil drilling location "KUP" & "KUL" co-terminus with Ningru PML in favour of Oil India Limited, Duliajan, Assam.
