**Subject: Diversion of 0.5705 ha. of forest land (instead of 0.5948) in favour of Snowfoam Energy Pvt. Ltd. for the construction of Hamshu-I SHEP (2MW) within the jurisdiction of Kullu Forest Division, Distt. Kullu, Himachal Pradesh. (Online No.FP/HP/HYD/39463/2019).**

Kindly refer to your memo No.Ft.48-4024/2019 (FCA) dated 09.09.2021 on the above cited subject.

2. In this context, DFO Kullu has intimated that user agency has changed Row of underground T/line from 1.0 mtr to 600 mm to use minimum forest land and avoid unnecessary felling of trees. Accordingly, user agency has revised the proposed diversion area to 0.5705 ha. (instead of 0.5948 ha.). The observations raised by MoEF & CC vide letter No.8B/HP/01/52/2020/FC/539 dated 03.07.2020 have been attended and reply is submitted as under:-

1. The user agency has applied for revised TEC with Directorate of Energy, HIMURJA. An undertaking in this regard is placed in the revised proposal folders at (page-49).
2. Supplementary IA is placed in revised proposal folders at (pg.52-55).
3. The power evacuation plan is placed in revised proposal folders at (pages-56-57).
4. The user agency has taken the Row of T/line as 600mm and proposal has been revised accordingly.
5. The revised CA Scheme has been placed in revised proposal folders at (pages-37-48).
6. The information regarding River Basin Study has already been submitted to your office by Directorate of Energy, HP and copy of the same is placed in revised proposal folders at (page-58).

Therefore, revised proposal folders (2Nos.) for diversion of 0.5705 ha of forest land (instead of 0.5948 ha) containing the revised documents viz. Part-I & II, Digital map, Toposheet, Layout Plan, Checklist No.7 & 8, comparative statement, revenue papers etc. are submitted for further needful action please.
