Government of India, Ministry of Environment, Forest and Climate Change (Forest Conservation Division), New Delhi vide letter under reference No.1 had sought compliance on 13 points. Accordingly, the Chief Conservator of Forests (T.), Kolhapur vide letter under reference No.2 has submitted the compliance of shortcomings on 12 points to this office. Remarks of the Chief Wildlife Warden, Maharashtra State on 1 point related to the Wildlife Wing have been received by this office vide reference No.3. Proposal for the disforestation of area 76.17 ha. Reserved Forest land under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 of Village Malharpeth, Sonaichiwadi, Marulhaveli & Girewadi, Tal. Patan, Dist.Satara for rehabilitation of Village Kolane, Tal.Patan, Dist.Satara from Chandoli National Park of Sahyadri Tiger Reserve. The proposal has been initiated by the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara. The non-forest area does not involve in this project. The site inspection report of the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara is enclosed on page no.21 to 23 and The site inspection report of the Chief Conservator of Forests (T.), Kolhapur is enclosed on page no.23A to 23C.

- 3.0 Sahyadri Tiger Reserve is the first Tiger Reserve of Western Maharashtra and 4th Tiger Reserve of Maharashtra State spreading over two protected areas ie. Koyna WLS and Chandoli NP and its adjoining area of 1165.57 sq.kms area. STR is located in the Sahyadri Ranges of the Western Ghats of Maharashtra. STR is northern most tiger habitat in western ghats protected by declaring it as Tiger Reserve on 5thJan, 2010.
- 4.0 It is one of the World Heritage Sites from Western Ghat declared by UNESCO. STR is highly important for conservation due to its unparallel biodiversity & endemism of species of flora & fauna. Hence it is part of one of the Biodiversity Hotspot. Koyna WLS is declared as "Important Bird Area" by Birdlife International. Forest area near Navja village is declared as "Medicinal Plant Conservation Area" by FRLHT, Bangalore. These areas constitute rich evergreen, semi-evergreen and moist deciduous forests.
- 5.0 The area is spread over 4 districts namely, Satara (Mahabaleshvar, Medha, Satara & Patantahasils), Sangli (Shairala tahasil), Kolhapur (Shahuvadi tahasil) and Ratnagiri (Sangameshvar, Khed tahasils).

6.0 The Northern Western Ghats extends from Dang in Gujarat to Dandeli in Karnataka. This range however is fragmented at many locations owing to human habitation hindering the movement of tigers and other such large mammals. However, these fragments do provide essential cover to

extant species here. Tigers have also been reported previously to range and move around in this stretch, but camera trap records within the limits of Sahyadri Tiger Reserve dates back to 2011 & 2018.

- 7.0 Govt. of Maharashtra has declared Chandoli Wildlife Sanctuary vide notification No. WLP-1085 CR-588/(I) dated 16th September, 1985 under section 18 of Wildlife (Protection) Act- 1972 for the purpose of protecting, propagating and development of Wildlife therein and its environment. The total area of notified sanctuary is 308.17 sq. kms. Then it is upgraded as Chandoli National Park adding one village Amboli of Kolhapur District and notified total area of 317.67 sq.kms vide Government of Maharashtra notification dated 14 May, 2004. This area is notified as part of Sahyadri Tiger Reserve on 5th January, 2010.
- 8.0 As provided in the Wildlife Protection Act, 1972 and Maharashtra Land Revenue Code, 1864 the concerning Collectors has already enquired into rights and concessions of the inhabitants and has also ascertained the willingness of the people to relocation. The status of rehabilitation of 33 villages from Chandoli National Park is as follows:

• Villages relocated by Irrigation Dept.:

9.0 Human in-habitations are mostly been established in fertile lands with assured water supply. Such sites within the forest area are limited and therefore are ecologically significant. Flat grounds along major nalas can support revival floral and faunal attributes and such attributes are completely lost, with the presence of intensive agricultural attributes. Relocation in Chandoli National Park have amply demonstrated the benefits of relocation, especially to wild herbivores and consequently to the whole eco-system. Relocation of village Kolane will make available an area of 128.89.90 ha. of private & 108.29.60 ha. of Revane land and also an area of 248.45.40 ha. of Forest area will be free from human interference.

10.0 The Collector Satara had prepared Sankalan Register of 79 project affected persons of Kolane Village, out of which 76 are Land holders and 3 are landless From this 7 PAPs accorded consent to Option-I with Rs 10 lakh package, remaining 72 PAPs accorded consent to Option-II of land to land and gaonthan rehabilitation. One group of 24 PAPs from this have selected two nearby patches of forest land 13.60 ha of Gat no. 380 of village Kille Machindragad and 11.09 ha of Gat no. 222 of village Lavanmachi of Walwa Tahsil, Dist, Sangli for Gaothan and land for agriculture. Second group of remaining 48 PAPs have selected four patches of forest land, 07.86 ha of Gat no. 811of village Malharpeth, 52.00 ha of Gat no. 226 of village Sonaichiwadi, 10.49 Ha.of Gat no.1067 and 2.71 Ha. Gat no.1566 of village Marul Haveli and 3.11 Ha. of Gat no. 101/1 of village Girewadi of Patan Tahsil, Dist, Satara.

Hence, the proposal for diversion of 76.17.00 ha. Reserve Forest land from gat no.811 of Malharpet, gat no 226 of Sonaichiwadi, Gat no. 1067 and 1566 of Marul Haveli, Gat no 101/1 of Girewadi Tal Patan from Satara Forest Division is submitted.

12.0 As per para 1.15 of Handbook issued vide Government of India's letter dated 28/03/2019, the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara has submitted complete justification for locating the project in the forest area to prove the project is site-specific as under:-

'The Project is in the larger interest of the nature conservation & hence for the rehabilitation of Village Kolanetahasil - Patan at Malharpeth, Girewadi, Marulhaveli & Sonaichiwadi Tal. - Patan, Dist. Satara. The topographical and geological situation the alignment given area verified by Dy. Conservator of Forest Satara and its Site Specific in nature. The implementing agency is Dy. Conservator of Forest Satara. Hence the proposal is categories as "Site Specific".

13.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara has certified that:-

- No suitable alternate land is available and the forest land required is the lowest minimum. (PPN-37)
- Density and Eco-value class:- Density is above 0.4 (Mixed plantation area). (PPN-21)
- 13.3 The Project involves felling of total 13779 number of trees. The Girth wise abstract is as under:- (PPN-57)

- 13.4 The proposed area does not form part of any existing National Park, Wildlife Sanctuary, Nature Reserve. (PPN-47)
- 13.5 The Proposed project is not likely to affect any monumental site of cultural, historical, religious, archaeological or recreational importance. (PPN-46)
- 13.6 There is no violation of the Forest (Conservation) Act 1980. (PPN-41)
- 13.7 The proposed forest area is beyond 10 kms from boundary of protected area i.e.away 20 km. from Chandoli National Park. (PPN-59)
- 14.0 Government of India vide letter dated 3/12/2018 of F.No.11-43/2013-FC has issued guidelines regarding compliance of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forests Rights) Act, 2006. As per these guidelines:-

'Accordingly, it is clarified that within the time period stipulated for compliance of Stage-I condition, Deputy Commissioner shall complete the process of compliance of FRA (including forwarding its findings to be concerned CF), hence for the purpose of the MoEF & CC, as per the provisions under the Forest (Conservation) amendment rules, 2016 the compliance under FRA is not required for consideration of in-principle approval. This has to be furnished by the State Government for consideration of the proposal by the Ministry for final approval'

Hence the Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara has certified that FRA certificate of Collector Satara has been applied and the same will be submitted on receipt from the Collector Satara, before Stage-2 clearance for the proposal, as per MoEF Guideline F.No.11-43/2013-FCD, dated 03/12/2018. We are bounded to submit FRA certificate before Stage-2 and we are promising you to submit it before Stage-2 clearance. (PPN-83)

- 15.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara has submitted the undertaking that:-
- As per the guideline of the Central Government dt. 20/05/2019 & dt. 06/01/2022 there is exemption from payment of Net Present Value (NPV) and cost of Compensatory Afforestation in the said proposal. (PPN-34 & 49)
- 15.2 Agrees to defray the cost of felling of trees. (PPN-54)
- 16.0 The KML file of the forest land proposed for diversion is enclosed and placed in the file at the top.
- 17.0 The Deputy Conservator of Forests, Satara Forest Division, Satara and the Chief Conservator of Forests (T.), Kolhapur have recommended the proposal for disforestation of 76.17 ha. of forest land. (PPN-13 to 17)
- 18.0 Nodal officer on 08/03/2022 had requested the Chief Wildlife Warden to offer their remarks in accordance with the Central Government's guideline dated 20/05/2019 for the said proposal. The Chief Wildlife Warden vide office note No.Desk-23(2)/WL/Survey/C.R.198 (Nodal)/3492/2021-22, dated 29/03/2022 has conveyed his remarks as follows:-

"Following area would be acquired due to rehabilitation of Village Kolane.

As per the details given above, the area to be disforested as per proposal of disforestation is 76.17 Ha. and in lieu of this, 237.19 Ha. land will be acquired and therefore approval to the proposal of disforestation has been accorded."

- 19.0 In view of this, the proposal is recommended for approval under section-2(ii) of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 subject to fulfilment of the following conditions:-
- 19.1 Legal status of the forest land diverted under the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for rehabilitation of Village Kolane, Tal.Patan, Dist.Satara from Chandoli National Park of Sahyadri Tiger Reserve shall cease to be forest land.
- 19.2 User Agency shall restrict the felling of trees to minimum numbers in the diverted forest land and trees shall be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department.
- 19.3 Land vacated in the protected area due to relocation of Village shall be developed as per approved Wildlife Management Plan/NTCA guideline/CWLW.
- 19.4 No fragmentation of forests should take place due to the relocation project.
- 19.5 The boundary of the diverted land shall be suitably demarcated on ground at the project cost as per the directions of the concerned Divisional Forest Officer.
- 19.6 The forest land shall not be used for any purpose other than that specified in the project proposal.
- 19.7 The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance of all the Court orders, provisions, rules, regulations and guidelines for the time being in force as applicable to the project.
- 19.8 Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act,1980 and action would be taken as per the MoEF&CC Guideline F.No.11-42/2017-FC, dt. 29/01/2018.
- 19.9 Any other condition that Ministry of Environment, Forest & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife. The State Government shall ensure compliance of all the above conditions.
