With reference to the above and as per the Govt. of India, Ministry of Environment forest & Climate Change, Bengaluru directions cited at reference (1) the information/clarification has been submitted vide this office letter dated: 16-05-2022 cited at reference (4).

As per Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Forest Conservation) and Nodal Officer (FCA), Bangalore's direction dated: 17-12-2022 cited at reference (2), the User Agency has submitted the quarry plan from Sree.kumary G., #481, Sri. Vainatheya Kruppa, 8th Main Road, Doddabommasandra, Vidyaranyapura, Bengaluru authorized person from the competent authority i.e. Director, Department of Mines and Geology, Bengaluru vide letter cited at

reference (5). Accordingly again the clarification/information along with approved quarry plan is submitted as under for onward submission to Govt. of India through proper channel.

Further, the user agency has stated vide reference (5) that as per the directions of Department of Mines and Geology which mentioned that under Karnataka Sub Mine Concessions Rule 1994 Amendment 2023, Rule 31ZC says that the name of the applicant for the Quarry and the Crusher (Form 'C') should be one and the same. Applicant have been granted crusher license under Form 'C' No: 23/DMG/UKD/CL/2020-21/1374 dated:18-12-2020 in the name of M/s. Shivaprasad Industries. Hence as per the requirements of Department of Mines and Geology, we submitted the proposal through proper channel for the change in applicant name for this quarry from M/s. Ramshree Construction Company to M/s. Shivaprasad Industries as owners of M/s. Ramshree Construction Company and M/s. Shivaprasad Industries are one and the same and we have been intimated by the concerned authority that, the name of the applicant for diversion of 8.80388 ha. forest land in F.Sy. No. 52A1A of Arga Village, Baad Hobli, Karwar Taluk, Uttar Kannada District for establishing stone quarry, dumping yards has been changed from M/s. Ramshree Construction Company to M/s. Shivaprasad Industries and as per the guidelines of the Mines and Geology the sketch has been revised and total area remains same.

The above proposed area has been inspected by me on 30-07-2024 along with Assistant Conservator of Forests, Karwar Sub-division, Karwar and Range Forest Officer, Karwar as per proposed quarry map and approved quarry plan map in little variations. But overall area is same. In this regard the User Agency has stated that, as per the guidelines of

the Mines and Geology the sketch has been revised and total area remains same. It will be accreted while complying the Stage-I Approval Conditions.

Hence, the reply may be considered and proposal may be approved as per Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023
