With reference to the letter cited above, this is to submit herewith the point-wise information/ documents sought are being furnished below for favour of your kind information and necessary action:

1.	Justification on the inescapability of locating this project in forest land, as the proposal is non-site specific.	Most of the area of this State Capital falls under notified forest land. As such, there is no alternate land available in and around Itanagar except the Reserve Forest & Wildlife Sanctuary, and the inescapability of locating this project in forest land is unavoidable. Further, the proposed site selected is non-site specific. However, specifically selected for waste management purposes only. This project will not only help keep the city clean but also indirectly contribute to controlling environmental pollution. The project is very important for the development of the people of the State. Therefore, early approval of Stage-I may be considered under section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980.
2.	Whether any alternative has been examined for this project, and if not examined, the reason for selecting this proposed site.	There is no alternate non-forest land available in and around the Capital region except the reserve forest/ Itanagar Wildlife Sanctuary. As such, there is no alternate land available in and around Itanagar except the Reserve Forest & Wildlife Sanctuary, and the inescapability of locating this project in forest land is unavoidable.
3.	The complete detail action taken report against the erring officials of the State Forest Department and user agency as per para 1.16 of Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam,1980,	The Offence report drawn by the Range Forest officer vide No. BJN/08/2020/109 Dated 11.10.2023 for violation of FC Act,1980 against the Itanagar Municipal Corporation.

	and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rules, 2023.	
4.	Whether the State Govt. has initiated action against the responsible person/staff/officer of the forest department for dereliction of duty, if not, the reason thereof.	When the offense was detected by the patrolling team of Banderdewa Forest Division, an offense report was promptly prepared against the offender, and the case was registered as detailed at Sl.No.(6).
5.	The date of initiation of work in the proposed area by the user agency, with the actual area broken down in the proposed area.	As reported by the user agency, the date of initiation of work in the proposed area on 12 th April'2023. However, as per the report submitted by DFO, Banderdewa. On 5 th May'2022 at 3:35 pm, the patrolling team of Range Forest Office, Balijan Forest Range detected that the illegal jungle clearance inside the RF area was going on by the Itanagar Municipal Corporation in violation of the FC Act,1980. The patrolling team directed them not to break forest land and instructed that prior approval from the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change, Government of India is mandatory.
6.	The date of detection of the violation by the State Forest Department and the action taken thereon.	On 11 th Oct'2023 at 10:30 AM, the Forest patrolling team detected illegal earth cutting being carried out inside the Reserve Forest area by miscreants. The offence case was drawn against the violator as per the FCA,1980.
7.	To clarify how the State Government was unaware of the development activities in the site without obtaining the prior approval of the Central Government under the F(C) Act,1980.	As per the report submitted by the DFO, Banderdewa Forest Division, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh, 1. The site where illegal earth cutting took place is inside the jungle, which is not visible from the road side as such, it could not be noticed. However, when patrolling was carried out by the patrolling team on 11 th Oct'2023. The Forest patrolling team detected illegal earth cutting being carried out inside the Reserve Forest area by miscreants, and promptly, the offence case was drawn against the violator as per the FCA,1980.
8.	If the permission for the use of forest land was given by the authorities concerned/ State Government, for the purpose of non-forestry activity, then who are the officials responsible for violation of FCA 1980 and what criminal proceedings has undertaken by the State Government.	No permission was granted by the Forest Department for the use of forest land for non-forestry purposes. However, on detection of illegal earth cutting by the patrolling team, the offence report was drawn against the user agency for violation of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980, and the same was forwarded to the Hon'ble court of Chief Judicial Magistrate, Yupia vide No. SUB/ 05/ 2023/ Cons/Part-II/4951-53 Dated 26.12.2023 for trial. 13.	The length and width of the approach road involved in the proposed area.	The length of the approach road is 2.5 km, and the width is 8 metres as proposed in this project.
14.	To clarify the nos. of trees to be felled in the proposed area as it is uploaded as 30 nos. whereas mentioned as 47 nos. in the site inspection report of DFO.	The number of trees in the proposed site, as per the enumeration done, is 47. (Above girth 12 nos.. and below girth 35 Nos. i.e., total 47 Nos. Of trees only. Therefore, the amount mentioned in 30 Nos. in Parivesh is incorrect and may be ignored.
15.	The aerial distance of the proposed area from the nearest distance of Wildlife Sanctuary/Protected Area/National Park.	As per the comment received from O/o CWLW, the proposed area falls inside Drupong Reserve Forest, and it lies at an aerial distance of approximately 3.76 km away from the boundary of Itanagar Wildlife Sanctuary. But falls within the extended Eco-Sensitive Zone of Itanagar WLS, as by default, the ESZ of Itanagar WLS is up to 10km away from the boundary of the sanctuary. (copy of letter dated.20 th Jan'2025) Received from the Conservator of Forests (WL&BD) is enclosed as Annexure-III
16.	To provide the consent of NBWL in case the proposed area is part of a Wildlife Sanctuary/Protected Area/National Park and its ESZ.	The User Agency, i.e., the Assistant Engineer, Itanagar Municipal Corporation, Itanagar, has applied for Wildlife Clearance vide. dated.15.07.2024, Proposal No. WL/ AR/ Others/487870/2024, Single Window No. SWM/160651/2022) for approval/consent from the Standing Committee of the National Board of Wildlife (NBWL), which is currently pending with the Wildlife Warden. 17.	Comment of the State Forest Department as the proposed area is INVIOLATE as per the DSS due to the presence of "very dense forest".	The Site proposed is covered with bamboo and wild bananas, which look like a very dense forest. But actually, there are no valuable trees in the said area. Since it is near the Capital Complex, it is suitable for the Solid Waste Management Plant.
18.	The copy of the PSC minutes as it is mandatory to submit as per Ministry's guideline dated 25.01.2024.	The copy of the PSC minutes is enclosed as Annexure-IV

In light of the above, it is therefore requested to kindly convey early approval in favour of diversion of 10 ha. of forest land for the establishment of Solid Waste Management Plant at Dapo Yarlo, Itanagar by Itanagar Municipal Corporation, Govt. of Arunachal Pradesh in Papum Pare District of Arunachal Pradesh under section 2 of the Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Adhiniyam, 1980 and Van (Sanrakshan Evam Samvardhan) Rule, 2023 at an early date.

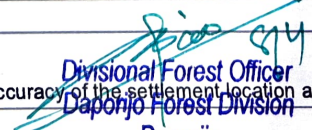
