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I submit herewith as per the instructions given by the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests, Chennai ref.No.TS3/7022/2020 dated 04.09.2020 vide reference 2nd cited above, the short comings were rectified as below:

1. The detailed CA scheme along with site suitability certificate for the identified non forest CA land has not been uploaded in the Project proposal. The District Forest Officer may be instructed to formulate the CA scheme based on the guidelines issued in the CA and uploaded in the project proposal.

The detailed CA scheme with 10 year maintenance to an financial outlay of 64.66 lakhs has been uploaded in the additional information section.

2. In the additional information details section CA land has been market as two bits in the as against the uploading of details in one bit under SL. No. 13(iii).

The user agency has earlier uploaded the Survey of India Toposheet in one bit in SL. No. 13(iii). Now they uploaded the Survey of India Toposheet as two bits in part 1 of Form-A.

3. Similarly Google map of identified CA land has been market as two bits in the Survey of India Toposheet as against the uploading of details in one bit under SL. No. 13(ii).

The user agency has earlier uploaded the Google map in one bit in SL. No. 13(ii). Now they have uploaded the Google map as two bits in part 1 of Form-A.

4. The District Forest Officer has not reported justification for acceptance for area already hander over to the Forest Department in S.F.No.416/1 with an extent of 51.83 ha as per the G.O(D) No.351, Revenue Department dt. 09.08.2002 and already notified u/s 4 of TNF Act 1882 vide G.O.No. 79, E&F (FR-14) Dept. dated 23.06.2020 has compensatory land for the project details.

An area of 114.45 ha of un-assessed Government waste land was diverted to the Forest Department as a Compensatory land from the revenue department vide G.O(D). No.351, Revenue Department dt. 09.08.2002 for various project. An area of 31.38 ha of un-assessed Government waste land in S.F.No.416/1 Vinnamangalam Village was diverted as excess CA with a condition that, the excess CA land should be utilized in future as a compensatory land when the projects needs diversion of forest land.
