Inviting a reference to the above cited Govt. letters on the captioned subject and discussion in the meeting held on 09.02.2023 under Chairmanship of the Additional Chief Secretary to Govt., FE &CC Deptt., I am directed to inform that Final Report on Carrying Capacity & Bio-diversity Assessment of the Daitari Iron Ore Mine (DIOM) of OMC Ltd. Odisha, prepared by ICFRE, Dehradun in association with Wildlife Institute of India, Dehradun contains specific recommendations and general recommendations vide para ES.11.1 & ES.11.2 of the Executive Summary respectively. The recommendations made in the Final Report may kindly be accepted except the findings of the report regarding location of Mining Lease area of DIOM, OMCL vis-àvis proposed Similipal-Satkosia Tiger Corridor.

It is mentioned in the Volume-I of the Final Report against SI. No.1 at Page 430 that Mining Lease area falls within the corridor forest linking the Similipal & Satkosia Tiger Reserves. The KML file of Corridor linking Similipal-Satkosia Tiger Reserves has been downloaded from the Decision Support System (DSS) of NTCA Website. It is mentioned in the DSS that for the time being, the user agency may like to download the 'KML' file and visualize the Protected Areas, Tiger Reserves and Corridors vis-à-vis their proposed developmental/ infrastructure projects. Copy of the Dash Board of NTCA Website enclosed herewith as Annexure-I. The KML file of Mining Lease area has been prepared basing on the DGPS Map of Mining Lease area duly authenticated by ORSAC, Bhubaneswar concerned DFOs and Dy. Director of Mines, Jajpur Road. Copy of the DGPS Map is enclosed herewith as Annexure-II. KML files of Similipal-Satkosia Tiger Corridor as well as Mining Lease area are sent herewith in soft copy (CD) for kind reference. On verification, it is seen that Mining Lease area of the DIOM, OMCL is not coming within Similipal-Satkosia Tiger Corridor. The map showing ML area of DIOM, OMCLQvis-à-vis proposed Similipal-Satkosia Tiger Corridor is appended herewith as Annexure-III for better appreciation. This fact may please be brought to the notice of all concerned.
