Diversion of 349.709 ha. of forest land within total mining lease area of 2290.449 ha in Siarmal Open Cast Coal Mining Project by Mahanadi Coalfields Ltd. (MCL) in Sundargarh District, Odisha

In inviting a reference to the Memo No. cited above, the User Agency has submitted the point wise report as per observation raised by the Additional Principle Chief Conservator of Forests, Forest Diversion & Nodal Officer, FC Act vide Memo under reference, the point wise compliances is furnished below:-

1) The UA has not furnished the document regarding acquisition of land for the project:

In compliance to the above, the UA has submitted that, Siarmal OCP is coming under Coal India Limited (CIL) block which has been dispensed by the Government of India. The acquisition of land coming under the project covers 06 (Six) villages viz. Gopalpur, Siarmal, Jhupurunga, Ratansara, Tumulia & Kulda in Sundargarh Forest Division of Sundargarh District, and stands acquired by the Central Government and the ownership is vested with MCL. The detail of notifications against which the land was acquired under CBA (A&D) is as mentioned below:

lb Block XI - Tiklipara (1743.85 Ac), Siarmal (852.34 Ac), Gopalpur (part)(140.67 Ac), Tumulia (2381.32 Ac), Kalikachhar (511.94 Ac), Kulda (542.85 Ac), Bankibahal (836.33 Ac), Balinga (1234.64 Ac), Garjanbahal (798.35 Ac), Kiripsira (1680.11 Ac) & Japti Jungle (Lalma RF) (420.00 Ac)=12209.33 Acres.

In this Forest Diversion Proposal six villages are included for diversion and the details of Villages falling in Siarmal OCP viz Siarmal, Jhupuranga, Tumulia, Ratansara, Gopalpur and Kulda.

A detailed Lease history submitted by the User Agency, is enclosed herewith as **Annexure-I** for your kind perusal.

The copies of 9(i) & 11(i) Gazette notifications submitted by UA have been attached herewith as **Annexure-II**.

2) Document in support of approval of Mining Plan and its validity are wanting

In compliance to the above, UA has stated that the Mining Plan & Mine Closure Plan of proposed Siarmal OCP has been approved by MCL board in its 198th meeting held on 31-01-2018. The copy of approval submitted by UA is attached herewith as **Annexure-III**. The validity of Mining Plan as declared by UA is for a period of 49 years i.e. the life of the mine.

3) Cost Benefit Analysis has not been furnished as per prevailing guidelines of MoEF&CC, Government of India.

In compliance to the above, the Cost Benefit Analysis has been revised and prepared as per the new guidelines of MoEF&CC, which is furnished herewith as **Annexure-IV**.

4) The DFO Sundargarh in Checklist no. 20 has mentioned regarding violation, but in site inspection report he has mentioned that there is no violation which is contradictory. You have mentioned in the site inspection report that there is no violation.

The check list serial no. 20 is correct and is tick marked ($\sqrt{}$). The one with cross (\times) is not to be considered as mentioned in the check list serial no. 20 below.

5) 64.091 Ha Revenue forest land proposed for diversion has been uploaded in Part-I Form-A pertaining to village Tumulia but authenticated land schedule 63.87 ha Revenue forest land has been furnished in the DP which is less by 0.218 ha.

In compliance to the above, the UA has stated that the complete land schedule of Forest land has been re-verified by UA and Tahasildar Hemgir and accordingly a fresh land schedule of complete Forest Land coming under the project, duly authenticated by Tahasildar Hemgiri, has

been attached herewith as **Annexure V**. The total Revenue Forest land pertaining to village Tumulia is coming to 64.092 Ha which is same as per Part-I Form-A.

6) In Siarmal Village Plot No. 568 P of Khata No. 51 the area of the plot as per RoR is 0.17 Ac whereas 0.5 Ac has been selected for mining.

In compliance to the above, the UA has made the necessary rectifications in lieu of Plot No. 568 P of Khata No. 51 of Siarmal Village in the revised land schedule attached herewith as Annexure-V (Page No.04).

7) The details of breakup of forest land furnished in the DP is not tallying with land schedule furnished in the DP village wise as mentioned below...

In compliance to the above, the UA has stated that as per the rectifications pointed out in point no. 05 & 06, and corresponding modifications in the land schedule, the breakup of forest land as per the corrected land schedule stands same as provided in part-I Form - A which is as furnished below:

8) 499.361 ha of non forest uploaded in Part-I Form-A pertaining Gopalpur Village but the UA has furnished the detail land schedule of non-forest Govt and Private land of 474.099 ha which is less by 25.262 ha.

In compliance to the above, the UA has submitted a supplementary land schedule comprising of 25.262 ha of Non-forest land, duly authenticated by Tehsildar Hemgir which is attached herewith as **Annexure-VI**.

9) The ORSAC vetted DGPS Map of Revenue forest land proposed for diverted has not been authenticated by the Tahasildar Hemgir.

In compliance to the above, the UA has submitted the ORSAC vetted DGPS map of Revenue forest land proposed for diversion after authentication by Tahasildar Hemgir. The authenticated DGPS map has been attached herewith as **Annexure - VII.**

10) The Collector Sundargarh has issued FRA Certificate on 21.06.2021 over 349.489 ha against diversion of 349.709 ha. The FRA certificate for balance forest area of 0.22 ha is required to be furnished. $3 \mid P \mid g \mid g \mid e$

In compliance to the above, the revised FRA certificate for 349./09 ha, including 0.22 ha issued by the Collector Sundargarh vide Letter No. 6217/VIII-05/2021 dt. 14.07.2021 is being furnished herewith as **Annexure – VIII**. Further, an undertaking to this effect has been submitted by the UA for submission of complete FRA for 349.709 Ha of forest land proposed to be diverted for the project which is enclosed herewith as **Annexure -IX**.

11) In Part-II Serial No. 4 the DFO Sundargarh Division has reported 350.11 ha of forest land is to be diverted instead of 349.709 ha.

In compliance to the above, as per the corrected land schedule of diverted area of the forest land required for the project, proposed by user agency in Form-A, Part-I (Page No. 1 to 8 in DP), the following break up of Part-II Serial No. 4 is furnished below.

12) The authorized signatory has not signed all the documents enclosed in the DP.

In compliance to the above, this is to confirm that all the documents in the DP have been signed by the authorized signatory of MCL.

13) The CA scheme the pit size is to be changed to 45 cm \times 45 cm \times 45 cm as 18 month old seedling will be planted.

In compliance to the above, the necessary rectification have been made and the size of pits have been changed to 45 cm x 45 cm x 45 cm. The revised CA Scheme with a total financial outlay of Rs.13, 51, 76,468.00 (taking wage rate @ 311.00 per man day) has been attached herewith as Annexure- X.

14) The Barbed Wire Fencing which may cause harm to wild animals is to be replaced by Vegetative Fencing.

In compliance to the above, the Barbed wire fencing has been replaced by Brush wood fencing with Bamboo twigs and the revised CA Scheme with a total financial outlay of Rs. 13, 51, 76,468.00 (taking wage rate @ 311.00 per man day) has been attached herewith as **Annexure -X**.

15) The UA has not furnished the Environment Clearance certificate.

In compliance to the above, the UA has stated that Environment Clearance for Siarmal OCP has been applied for vide: IA/OR/CMIN/24164/2014, J-11015/230/2014-IA-II (I). The detailed status of Environment Clearance and an undertaking to this effect submitted by the UA is attached herewith as **Annexure-XI**.

16) The UA has not furnished the map of mining plan and phased reclamation plan.

In compliance to the above, the UA has submitted the maps in respect of stage wise mining plan and phase wise reclamation, which is attached herewith as

Annexure- XII.
