In the reference 8<sup>th</sup> and 9<sup>th</sup> cited, the Deputy Conservator of Forests (Central), MoEF, GoI, RO, Chennai has informed that vide Ministry's guideline 3.2 (ix) (F), it has been clarified that "the provisions of the above guideline would be applicable only to Central Sector Projects and not on State Sector Projects which are being undertaken by Central PSUs on turnkey basis. In such cases, Compensatory Afforestation on equivalent non-forest land/a certificate of Chief Secretary regarding non-availability of equivalent non-forest land anywhere in the State Shall be insisted upon".

Accordingly, the User Agency was requested to identify equivalent non-forest land suitable for CA adjacent to the existing forest land and conduct DGPS survey only if the non-forest land identified is found suitable for raising Afforestation. Submit details of raw-data of DGPS survey of CA land conducted in both hard and soft copies for verification and authentication by this office for the (2) road projects i.e., from Nizamabad to Jagadalpur Section of NH-63 and from Nizamabad to Armoor on 01-12-2018.

In this regard it is submitted that the User Agency i.e., Engineer-in-Chief, R&B (NH), CRF & Bldgs., Hyderabad vide reference 10<sup>th</sup> cited (copy enclosed) has informed that the National Highways are the property of Government of India. The MoRT&H/ GoI allocates the funds for development and maintenance of NHs. The PWD(R&B) and NHAI are the existing agencies for NHs under the control of them. Some important NHs are entrusted to NHAI for development to 4L/6L standards and relatively less important NHs are entrusted to State R&B NH wing for development to 2L/4L with paved shoulders. There are 23 National Highways in

the State of Telangana covering a length of 3862 km criss-crossing the State. Out of which, 2044 km are with NHAI for development under National Highways Development Project(NHDP) and 1818 km are under control of (R&B) NH wing. The Nizamabad – Jagadalpur Section of NH-63 which starts from Nizamabad in Telangana state and ends at Jagadalpur of Chattisgarh State passing through Telangana, Maharashtra and Chattisgarh States is under the control of (R&B) NH wing.

Further, Engineer-in-Chief has stated that the Ministry have accorded Technical Approval and Financial Sanction for the works "Widening and Strengthening from km 180/600 to km 223/000 of Nizamabad – Jagadalpur road Section of NH-63" for an amount of Rs.248.83 Crores under job no.:NH-63 (old NH-16)-TS-2016-17-029 & "Four laning from km 4/8 to km 24/6 (i.e. Nizamabad to Armoor) of Nizamabad to Jagadalpur Section of NH-63 (old NH-16)" for an amount of R.117.56 Crores under Job No.63(Old NH-16)-TS-2015-16-249 (copies enclosed). As such the above projects on NH-63 are purely 100% Central Sector Projects and not State Sector Projects. Finally stated that, equivalent non-forest CA Land is not applicable for the above (2) projects and Government of India has not made any provision for CA.

In view of the above, it is requested to examine the request of Engineer-in-Chief (R&B) NH of State of Telangana and communicate the orders for taking necessary action.

- 1.8 Road furniture & Road safety: 31 Nos of Bus Bays and one Truck lay-byes, Caution, mandatory, junction boards, hazard markers, crash barriers-4.80km, M.S. railing in the median in built up area -17.82Km, retaining wall etc. are included in the estimate.

- 3. Land Acquisition & Forest Clearance: It is reported by State PWD that 93% of project length is available for the proposed work. The diversion of Forest land in Kundarama Reserve Forest from Km. 184.900 to Km. 189.400 is not required. The status of diversion of Reserve Forest lands in Chennuru Reserve Forest from Km. 192.800 to Km. 199.000 and in Venchpalli Reserve Forest from Km. 212.750 to 216.890 is under process for stage II clearance. The proposals for Stage-I clearance for curve improvement from Km. 196.000 to Km. 197.000 of Chennur Reserve Forest at Gollavagu has to be initiated. Further, State (R&B) Deptt., Telangana has informed that there is no objection from Forest Department for widening of the existing road within our Right of Way even though the stretch is passing through forest area.
- 4. Previous Improvements: Strengthening from km 199/0 to 220/0(excluding missing links in km 199/0-300, km 213/240-800, km 215/930 to km 216/650) in the proposed section is recently completed on 24.11.2015 and Defect Liability Period (DLP) for this work is 3 years. In this connection, State PWD has reported that these stretches are excluded in the reconstruction proposals as the strengthening is completed recently. In the present proposal this stretch is proposed with wearing course of 40 mm BC only, since the commencement of EPC works may take around 6-9 months and if its completion period is taken as 24 months the completion period of EPC work may be around by March, 2019, by that time, the defect liability period of earlier contract will be completed and hence the wearing coarse of this stretch may be taken up in the last mile stone after completion of DLP.
  - 5. <u>Design specifications including deviations, if any:</u> All Materials, works and construction operations shall conform to the Manual of Specifications and Standards for Two-Lane Highways (IRC:SP:73-2015) published by IRC (referred to as "Manual" in this Schedule) and MORTH Specifications for Road and Bridge Works (fifth revision 2013). ## 6. Contract Documents including deviations, if any:

- 6.1 As per Ministry's circular no. RW/NH-37010/4/2010/PIC dated 31.12.2013, RFP may be invited for the project in single stage two cover systems.
- RFP and draft contract documents are as per the draft Model RFP and EPC documents approved by the Ministry after making project specific changes as well as amendments circulated by Ministry vide circular No. RW/NH-37010/4/2010/PIC-EAP(Printing) dated 05.10.2015 & 04.01.2016.
- 6.3 Construction Period: Construction period for this work has been proposed as 24 months including the rainy period. Defects liability period and maintenance period has been considered as 4 years as specified in the Model EPC Document approved by the Ministry.

## 7. Cost estimates:

- 7.1 The estimate is based on the Ministry's Standard Data Book and State Schedule of Rates, 2015-16 for Telangana PWD.
- Contingencies @ 2.8%, Supervision charges @ 3%, Agency charges @ 3%, Quality Control @ 0.25%, Road Safety @ 0.25%, Escalation @ 10% for 2 years' construction period [5% for each year, totalling 10%] and Maintenance charges @ 5.0 % for four years [0.5% for 1st year &1%, 1.5% &2% for 2<sup>nd</sup>, 3rd and 4th year respectively; total 5.0%] has been considered in the estimate as per Ministry's circulars dated 14.08.2013,15.01.2014,05.10.2015 & 04.01.2016.

#### 8. General observations:

- The provision of contingencies should be utilized as per Ministry's circular letter no. RW/G-20011/8/98-WA(R) dated 16.08.2002 & Ministry's circular No. NH-15017/17(2)/2016-P&M dt. 16.06.2016 ,delegation of powers for acceptance of variations vide NH 18011/1/2012-P&M dated 23.09.2016..
- 8.2 Collection of material should be so planned that it should commensurate with the physical progress of work and the collected material should not cause any hindrance to the traffic. It must be ensured that the contractor arranges for separate land for storage of road construction material and machinery and these shall not be allowed to be stacked on roadside.
- 8.3 No work beyond the scope of the sanctioned estimate leading to increase in the scope of the work or change in specification should be undertaken without obtaining prior written approval of the Ministry. In case, the estimate needs revision due to change in rates/tender rates for any reasons, the revised estimate shall be submitted immediately for Ministry's approval..
- In order to ensure that there is no slippage in achieving the targets, the progress may be closely monitored by CE(NH) Andhra Pradesh, RO Hyderabad and quarterly status report furnished to the Ministry in the prescribed proforma.
- During the course of execution, the traffic may be regulated in accordance with guidelines laid down vide Ministry's letter no. NHIII-33 (126)/72 dated 20.03.1973 and letter No.RW/NH-11060/1/1998-D.O.1 dated 07.10.1987. Smooth flow of the traffic may be ensured by providing adequate traffic control devices in accordance with stipulation of IRC: SP: 55:2001 "Guidelines on Safety in construction Zone".
