The pointwise reply to the observations as raised vide your above referred communication is submitted as below:-

- 1. The area selected for CA is suitable for plantation of 1100 trees/hectare & crown density of the area is less than 0.4. Certificate in this regard as received from DFO concerned is enclosed herewith.
- 2. The employment details has been corrected at Para E (ii) of Part-I online.
- 3. The dumping sites cannot be shifted to private land as the private land owners are not agreed to donate their land for the same purpose. Moreover, the land holders are very less & no tress are standing on this forest land.
- 4. No trees are involved over the forest land proposed for dumping site.
- 5. The user agency has submitted that the width of already constructed road is less than 5/7 mtr. which is not as per the HPPWD standard. The width of motorable road should be 5/7 mtr as per the HPPWD specification. The existing road is a jeepable road.
