Nodal Officer, Central University, Borth Campus, Dharamshala, District Kangra (H.P.) has submitted the proposal for the Diversion of Forest land for the construction of Central University, North Campus at Dharamshala Project in Distt. Kangra. The detail of Forest land to be diverted for construction of project is given as under:-



The User Agency has not provided the non Forest land for raising for compensatory Afforestation and as such the compensatory Afforestation scheme on 151 Ha. in Dhar Narwana, CFS Khanyara, UP Lam I and Kandi, for Rs.2,71,64,900/- in lieu of forest land being diverted for the construction of Central University of Himachal Pradesh North Campus Dharamshala falling in Tehsil Dharamshala in Distt. Kangra, has been prepared and enclosed with the proposal. The user agency has agreed to pay the cost of Compensatory Afforestation and Net Present Value under the provision. As per revised check list of documents pertaining to the proposal is enclosed with the folders.

It is therefore, requested that the necessary approval for the diversion of 75.3931 Ha. of forest land for the construction of above mentioned project may kindly be obtained from the Govt. of India under Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and conveyed to this office.
