In inviting a kind reference to the letters cited above on the captioned subject, I finished below the point -wise compliance report on the observation raised by the OSD-Cum-Special Secy. to Govt. of Odisha, Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department for favour of kind information & necessary action.

Points No.1

The following Plot numbers of (Revenue Forest Land i.e. Jungle, Jungle Bagayat Gramy Gungle) which form a part of the land proposed to be diverted had undergone Compensatory Afforestation. Their mutation has not yet been done. The details are as follows:

Objection raised by the OSD-cum-Special Secretary, Govt. of Odisha, Forest, Environment & Climate Change Department vide their office letter No. 21643/FE & CC, dtd. 05.12.2022,

which was subsequently forwarded to the Tahasildar, Jharsuguda Tahasil vide this office letter No.3379 dt. 16.06.2023, No. 485 dt. 25.01.2023 & No. 2914 dt. 24.05.2023 & the reply received from the Tahasildar, Jharsuguda is enclosed herewith in *Annexure-I* for your reference.

The Tahasildar, Jharsuguda has contended that the actual Plot areas (104.5 acres) of the three plots exceed the area given (70.8 acres) for the purpose of Compensatory Afforestation and thereby the afforestation was done in a greater area than provided for the purpose.

From the site inspection report of the DFO, Jharsuguda and the forest growth in the area, it is clear that compensatory afforestation was carried out in the Plot No. 1690, 1379, 1380 of Khata No. 754 in Mouza Balijori, which form a part of the area proposed to be diverted. However, the extant records in this office cannot help determine with certainty the exact GPS-linked boundaries of the CA plantation.

In light of this ambiguity, an effort has been made to divorce the issue of mutation of the said CA land from the issue of the current diversion. In this regard, a fresh transfer/mutation request has been sent to the Tahasildar, Jharsuguda vide letter No.3569 dt.23.06.2023, No.3574 dt.23.06.2023 with a copy endorsed to User Agency for the CA land demarcated for the two projects so the principle of land-for-land is preserved. The undersigned also seeks further directions in this regard. Further, the copy of the Stage-I & Stage-II approval order of above two GRIDCO Projects (Now OPTCL) is enclosed in Annexure-II.

Point No.2

The Govt. of Odisha, Forest & Environment Department vide their letter No.21689/F&E dt.22.12.2009 (copy enclosed) has mentioned that the economic plantation with valuable species NPV shall be charged @9,39,000.00 per/Ha. (Eco-Class- I & II of "Dense Forest"). Which now is, as per revised rate of NPV, @ 14,36,670.00 per/ Ha.

From site inspection report of the DFO and the records available in the office, the land proposed to be diverted underwent compensatory afforestation. Therefore, to err on the side of caution, the undersigned is of the opinion that the forest area in the land proposed for diversion be considered as Eco-Class II (instead of Eco-Class III) to prevent any potential loss in recovery of NPV in the diversion proposal.

After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government and the recommendation of the State Government and the recommendation of the State Advisory Group, the Central Government hereby conveys its approval under Section 2 of Forest (Cons.) I am directed to refer to your letter No. 10 F(Cons.)79/99.20275/F&B dated 18.11.1999 and the letter No. 10F(Cons)77/99.5574/F&E dated 3rd April, 2001 on the above mentioned subject seeking prior approval of the Central Government in accordance with Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and to say that the proposal has been examined by the Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under Section-3 of the above said Act ..

After careful-consideration of the proposal of the State Government and on the basis of recommendations of the above mentioned Advisory Committee, the Central Government hereby conveys its approval under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for diversion of 46 ha. of forest land for construction of 220 KV/DC line from Budhipadar to Bolangir via Burla In favour of M/s. GRIDCO Ltd. In Jharsuguda, Sambhalpur, Bargarh & Bolangir districts of Orissa subject to the fulfillment of following conditions:-

Legal status of forest land shall remain unchanged. (i)

Compensatory afforestation shall be raised over degraded forest land twice in (ii) extent to the forest land being diverted i.e. over 92 ha. at the project cost.

The penal compensatory afforestation shall be carried out over degraded forest land twice in extent to the area involved in violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 at the project cost.

The action initiated by Chief Conservator of Forests (Central), Bliubaneshwar for violation committed on revenue forest land will continue.

out at the cost of user agency as per the echeme prepared by the State Forest Department and under their guidance.

The maximum width of right of way for transmission line on forest land shall be 35 motros.

Below each conductor, width clearance of 3 metres would be permitted for taking (IV) the tension stringing equipment. The trees on such strips would have to be folled - that should be kept to minimum and after stringing works is completed, the natural regeneration will be allowed to come up. Felling/pollarding/pruning of trees will be done at the minimum level and with the patrillation of the local forest officer whenever necessary to maintain the electrical clearance. One outer strip shall be left clear to permit maintenance of the transmission line.

(vili) Minimum clearance between conductors and trees shall be 4.6 metree. The sag and swing of the conductors are to be kept in view while working out the

minimum clearance mentioned above.

(ix) In the case of transmission lines to be constructed in hilly areas, where adequate olearance is already available, trees will not be cut, pollarded or pruned.

The user agency will make arrangement for free supply of fuel wood preferably (x)alternate energy source to labourers and staff working on the project site so as to avoid any pressure on the adjacent forest areas.

(k) Any other condition which the State Govt or the Chief Conservator of Forests (Contral), Regional Office, Lucknow may impose from time to time in the interest of afforestation and protection & improvement of the flora and fauna in the area.

- After careful consideration of the proposal of the State Government, the Central Government hereby agrees in principle for diversion of 46 ha. of forest land for construction of 220 KV/DC line from Budhipadar to Bolangir via Burla in favour of M/s. GRIDCO Ltd in Orissa subject to the following conditions:-
- The user agency will transfer the cost of compensatory afforestation over double (i) the degraded forest land i.e., 92 ha. (revised as on date to incorporate existing wage structure) in favour of the State Forest Department.
- The user agency will transfer the cost of penal compensatory afforestation over degraded forest land twice in extent to the area involved in violation of F(C) Act, 1980 (revised as on date to incorporate existing wage structure) in favour of the State Forest Department. After receipt of the compliance report on the fulfillment of the above conditions from the State Government, formal approval will be issued in this regard under Section-2 of the Forest (Conservation) Act , 1980. It has been requested in the letter dated 24.05.2023 of DFO, Jharsuguda to mutate and transfer Ac. 227.47 decl. of revenue forest land including the aforesaid 5.73 acres land. The letter further reveals that the said 227.47 acres revenue forest land was earlier identified for compensatory afforestation purpose in lieu of diversion of forest land of 46.00 Ha. for construction of 220 KV DC line from Budhipadar, Jharsuguda to Bolangir by M/s. GRIDCO and accordingly, plantation was done by forest department.

Earlier, it has also been requested in letter dated 25.01.2023 of DFO, Jharsuguda to mutate and transfer of 32.40 ha of revenue degraded forest land identified in village Malimunda & Balijori under Jharsuguda Tahasil in lieu of diversion of 16.198 ha for forest land for construction of 2nd 220 KV/DC line from IB Thermal to Budhipadar in which compensatory afforestation plantation has been taken up by Forest Department.

Revenue forest land of Ac. 227.29 decl. was identified in Mouza-Malimunda & Balijori. The details are given below.

Out of the above three plots, Plot No. 1379 has been identified for CA purpose for diversion of 16.198 ha for forest land for construction of 2nd 220 KV/DC line from IB Thermal to Budhipada and rest two all diversion of form diversion of forest land of 46.00 Ha. for construction of 220 KV DC line from Budhipadar, Jharsuguda to Bolangir.

It is further revealed from the above statement that out of the total area of Ac. 104.50 involving the above three plots, Ac. 70.80 has been identified for CA purpose leaving residual area of Ac. 33.70. Earlier, there was an earthen road from Lecture Colony-II to Balijori chowk. After verification of official records at this end, it is found that out of the above residual area of Ac. 33.70, the Forest Department has used Ac. 23.76 area for compensatory afforestation purpose which also includes Ac. 2.00 approximately for nursery purpose. The 220 KV DC line project is on one side of the earthen road giving a 314 ft wide corridor for the future expansion of the existing earthen road.

Mutation of the CA land has not been done till date and the land as of now stands recorded under Rakhit Khata. After receipt of formal request from DFO, Jharsuguda, mutation process will be done for eventual record of the land in favour of Forest Department.
