
With reference to above mention subject compliance of your EDS dated 15.02.2018 is based on information provided by CCF/DCF/UA as follows.

S.N.	Observation raised by MOEF	Compliance by UA/DCF/CCF
1	Details of alternative examined have not given	The proposed road alignment is taken on previous road. Therefore no alternate route are taken. Justification of User Agency and DCF Baran for alternatives is uploaded in part I and Hard copy is enclosed.
2	Layout plan and cross section showing the forest area requirement and area calculation sheet has not been provided.	Layout plan and cross section showing the forest area requirement and area calculation sheet has been uploaded in part I of the proposal and hard copy is attached.
3	Required no objection certificate is not provided	No objection certificate from concern DCF Baran is uploaded in part I and Hard copy is enclosed.
4	Violation of FCA Act has been reported & FIR has been lodged against contractor/driver by ROF. However the area of the violation has not been specified.	As per revised site inspection report and panchnama of DCF Baran specified 4.00 hac. Area was violated by User Agency in the proposal. Details are uploaded in part II. Hard copy is enclosed.
5	Entire area falling under forest proposed for construction has been included in diversion proposal, where as the road is claimed to be pre existing, it needs clarification.	As per UA/DCF Baran justification report, the proposed gravel road is earlier before 1980. Bitumin was taken in the year of 1984-85. No diversion was taken earlier therefore land for forest diversion is needed for construction of proposed road.

6	As per DSS analysis 1 ha only out of 13.56 ha. proposed for CA is not found suitable. This may be reexamined.	As per DCF suitability certificate, 1100 plants (as per model of Rajasthan) can be planted on the proposed non forest land. The proposed non forest land is suitable for planting.
