

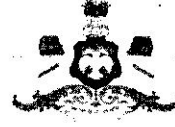

With reference to the above subject, this office vide Ref (1) letter dated 30-01-2020 has submitted a copy of recommendation of the Standing Committee of National Board for Wildlife to the Government of Karnataka and requested to forward the same to Government of India. In response, the Government of India vide Ref (2) has requested the Government of Karnataka to furnish the conditions proposed by Chief Wildlife Warden and to furnish the proposal online for further processing of the same.

Accordingly, this office vide Ref (1) letter dated 17-02-2021 has sought the conditions proposed in the Wildlife Clearance from Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) and Chief Wildlife Warden, Bengaluru. In response, the Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Wildlife) and Chief Wildlife Warden vide Ref (3) has submitted a copy of PART-IV of the Wildlife Clearance proposal to this office (copy enclosed). The condition proposed in the PART-IV vide Sl.No.9 is as follows.

“The work shall be taken up only under the close supervision of the jurisdictional officers and staff, to avoid any damage to the flora and fauna”


