2 The reply to the observations is furnished as under:-

2	The TEC & IA are stated to be under process with DoE. Comments of DoE may be furnished.	In respect of TEC and IA, the User Agency has submitted the ACS (Forest), Govt. of H.P letter No. FFE-B-G(6)-7/2006 dated 02.04.2009 stating that "FCA clearance for Power Project not to withhold processing of FCA clearance cases for want of Techno Economic Clearance. For the " In-Principle" clearance the TEC may not be insisted upon, it may however be made a condition for the issue of " Final Clearance". Copy of the same has been uploaded online along with EDS reply.
3	Allotment letter of the project from Himurja has not been submitted. It is required to be submitted.	Allotment letter of the project has already been placed in proposal folder at page No. 69 to 78 and complete proposal folder has been uploaded online in Part-I.
4	Evacuation plan duly approved by HPSEBL or HPPTCL is required to be submitted.	The User Agency has stated that as per Hydro Power Policy 2006 and

		as per allotment No. vide clause No. 18 (a) stated that solid tap connectivity at the nearest or 11KV or 22 Kv line up to 2.00 MW capacity generation will be allowed with appropriate protection. For Choj-1 (0.5MW) SHEP, there is already a 11KV transmission line existing in proposed power house area.
5	The approach road to be proposed has not been proposed.	The User Agency has stated that there is no need to construct approach road to proposed power house because they have to install a temporary ropeway for shifting of material of proposed power house.

FCA Clearance for Power Projects.

Subject: -

Sr.

I am directed to say that several Hydro Electric Power Projects both large and small are proposed to be set up in H.P. To develop these projects expeditiously, it is important that various clearances for these projects are obtained in time so that the State starts obtaining its share of additional power at the earliest. The Power Department has pointed out in a meeting that the Forest Department is insisting on Techno Economic Clearance of the project before case under FCA is processed and forwarded to the Govt. of India. In a Power project, various statutory clearances (such as under FCA) are required, and these have to be taken up in parallel, as a sequential approach will lead to huge delays. The TEC and FCA can both be done in parallel, and the forest should not be made a pre-condition for processing the FCA clearance.

You are, therefore, requested to direct all CF's/DFO's dealing with FCA clearance for power projects not to withhold processing of FCA clearance cases for want of Techno Economic Clearance. For the "In Principle" clearance the TEC may not be insisted upon, it may however be made a condition for the issue of "Final Clearance". M.S. (S) (S)
