With reference to the Government of India letter 8th cited, I wish to inform the following.

The Deputy Director General of Forests (Central), Government of India, MoEF&CC, RO, Chennai has conducted a meeting on 06.03.2024 to discuss the proposal and the Divisional Engineer, Metro, Assistant Divisional Engineer, CMDP and other officials participated in the meeting and the Government of India has informed to furnish the additional details for further consideration of the proposal.

Additional details on the proposal are furnished below.

(i) The user agency and project proponents have applied two separate forest clearance proposal at different dates and different project proponents. Proposals have been processed based on the area applied and for the diversion of below one ha area, compensatory land has not been insisted following the guidelines issued under the Forest Conservation Act 1980.

ii) For the diversion of 4.46 ha of forest land in Vandalur RF for formation of Tambaram Eastern Bypass road branching from km 17/4 of Malmalong bridge-Irumbuliyur road from Rajakilpakkam via Agaramthen road towards Perungalathur at km 0/0-9/300 in Chengalpattu District in favour of the Divisional Engineer, Highways, Chennai Metropolitan Development Plan Division-I, Chennai, the user agency has identified compensatory land in SF. No. 96/1 of Vedhanarayanapuram village in Chengalpattu District to an extent of 8.92 ha. Above survey field total extent is 31.09 ha, and part of area of 8.92 ha selected as compensatory land.

a) No other area in this hillock was given as Compensatory land for any earlier FC proposal.


b) For the proposal furnished for declaration of land under section 4 of Tamil Nadu Forest Act 1882 for converting the land as Reserve Forests for the extent of 31.09 Ha in Survey No.96/1 in Vedhanarayanapuram village at Chengalpattu District, the District Collector, Chengalpattu vide his letter N.Ka.No.8265/2021/A2 Dt.06.03.2023, replied to Chief Conservator of Forests, Chennai Circle that, the proposal under section 4 notification could not be considered, since this land shall be utilized for compensatory afforestation for various other Government projects.

c) It is observed that, the land is already having vegetation and forest like characteristics. Compensatory Afforestation plantation can't be taken up on this land. Thus, Compensatory Afforestation plantation may be taken up in degraded forest area. While accepting the above survey field number area may be accepted as Compensatory Afforestation land. This non forest CA land is a part of hillock that is adjacent to Palar River. Also, it is located at a distance of 400 mtrs from existing Hanumanthapuram RF. Compensatory afforestation has been proposed in 8.92 ha of degraded forest area in Gudalur RF.

d) Already for one other diversion proposal, land parcel in same hillock is being considered as Non forest Compensatory Afforestation land and hillock is of 31 Ha, hence it is found suitable for compensatory land, provided that this hillock of 31 Ha should be earmarked for Compensatory Afforestation purpose only.

I request that the additional details may be considered and forwarded to Government of India for further consideration of forest clearance proposals forwarded for approval.
