



**Sub: Proposal for de-notification of 197.93 hectares of forest land for Mandi Deep Industrial area in Raisen district, Madhya Pradesh - regarding.**

Sir,

I am directed to refer to Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Land Management) and Nodal Officer, Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Government of Madhya Pradesh's letter No. F-5/617/2009/10-11/1667 dated 27.07.2009 on the subject mentioned above, seeking prior approval of Central Government under **Section-2(i)** of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980. After careful consideration of the proposal by the Forest Advisory Committee constituted by the Central Government under Section-3 of the said Act, *In-principle/Stage -I* approval for the proposal was granted by this Ministry's letter of even number dated 20.12.2017 subject to fulfillment of certain conditions prescribed therein. The State Government has furnished compliance report in respect of the conditions stipulated in the *In-principle/Stage-I* approval and has requested the Central Government to accord **Final/Stage-II** approval.

*In this matter the Hon'ble Supreme Court in their order dated 15.07.2011 directed that I.A. Nos 2792-2793 are allowed in terms of the conditions enumerated in the Report of CEC dated 19.01.2011.*

In this connection, I am directed to say that on the basis of the compliance report furnished by Addl. Principal Chief Conservator of Forests (Land Management) and Nodal Officer, the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980, Government of Madhya Pradesh vide their letters No. F-5/617/2009/10-11/1602 dated 29.05.2020, letter No. F-5/617/2009/10-11/2923 dated 03.09.2020, letter No. F-5/617/2009/10-11/4271 dated 14.12.2020, letter No. F-5/819/2018/10-11/963 dated 15.03.2021 and letter No. F-5/617/2009/10-11/2440 dated 22.07.2021 '**Final /Stage-II approval**' of the Central Government is hereby accorded under **Section-2(i)** of the Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 for de-notification of 197.93 hectares of forestland for Mandi Deep Industrial area in Raisen district, Madhya Pradesh, subject to fulfillment of the following conditions:

**A: Conditions which need to be complied prior to handing over of forest land to user agency by the State Govt.:**

- i. The User Agency shall implement the Rehabilitation & Resettlement (R&R) Plan as per the R&R Policy of State Government in consonance with National R&R Policy,

Government of India before the commencement of the project work and implementation. The said R&R Plan will be monitored by the State Government/Regional Office of MoEF&CC along with indicators for monitoring and expected observable milestones;

- ii. The State Government shall ensure that compliance of Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act, 2006 has been completed in accordance with the relevant Rules and Guidelines issued by the MoEF&CC in this regard, before handing over of forest land to the user agency;
- iii. The State Government shall upload the KML files of the area under diversion and the accepted area for raising compensatory afforestation in the E-Green Watch portal of FSI, before handing over forest land to the user agency;

**B: Conditions which need to be complied after handing over of forest land to the user agency by the State Govt.:**

- i. Legal status of the diverted forest land shall be revenue land;
- ii. Compensatory Afforestation shall be raised over equal identified non-forest lands (NFL), which have already been notified as forests under the relevant provisions of India Forest Act-1927 by the State Government against this proposal, and at-least 1600 tall plants per hectare ( $197.93 \text{ hectares} \times 1600 = 316688 \text{ plants}$ ) shall be planted. CA will be carried out in large size pits (0.60 m x 0.6 m x 0.6 m). Good soil will be brought to replace existing inert soil dug out from the pits and at least 2 years old tall plants will be planted with provision for ten years on subsequent maintenance;
- iii. The User Agency shall pay the additional amount of NPV, if so determined, as per the final decision of the Hon'ble Supreme Court of India;
- iv. The State Govt. shall ensure that the User Agency shall obtain the Environment Clearance as per the provisions of the Environmental (Protection) Act, 1986, if required;
- v. Felling of trees on the forest land being diverted shall be reduced to the bare minimum and the trees should be felled under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- vi. The user agency shall explore the possibility of translocation of maximum number of trees identified to be felled and shall ensure that any tree felling shall be done only when it is unavoidable and that too under strict supervision of the State Forest Department;
- vii. The user agency shall provide alternate fuels to the labourers and the staff working at the site so as to avoid any damage and pressure on the nearby forest areas;
- viii. Boundary of the forest land proposed to be diverted shall be demarcated on ground at the project cost, by erecting four feet high reinforced cement concrete pillars, each inscribed with its serial number, forward and back bearing, distance from pillar to pillar and GPS coordinates;
- ix. No damage to the flora and fauna of the adjoining area shall be caused;
- x. The concerned Divisional Forest Officer, will monitor and take necessary mitigative measures to ensure that there is no adverse impact on the forests in the surrounding area.;

- xi. The User Agency shall submit the annual self-compliance report in respect of the above stated conditions to the State Government, concerned Integrated Regional Office and to this Ministry by the end of March every year regularly;
- xii. The User Agency and the State Government shall ensure compliance of provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations, Guidelines, relevant Hon'ble Court Order (s) and National Green Tribunal (NGT) Order(s), if any, pertaining to this project for the time being in force, as applicable to the project;
- xiii. The Violation of any of these conditions will amount to violation of Forest (Conservation) Act, 1980 and action would be taken as per the para 1.21 of comprehensive guidelines issued vide this Ministry F. No.5-2/2017-FC dated 28th March, 2019;
- xiv. Any other condition that the Ministry of Environment, Forests & Climate Change may stipulate from time to time in the interest of conservation, protection and development of forests & wildlife shall be carried out by the State Government and User Agency;
- xv. The State Government and User Agency shall ensure compliance of all conditions stipulated in the Stage-I approval letter dated 20.12.2017 for which undertakings have been obtained from the user agency and also the provisions of the all Acts, Rules, Regulations and Guidelines, relevant Hon'ble Court Order (S) and NGT Order (S), if any, pertaining to this project for the time being in force, as applicable to the project.
