Compliance to the letter dated:08-09-2017 is as follows for the 0.809 Ha area proposed for construction of Panchayath Office building in Maninalkur Block – II at Sy.no:124/p of Maninalkur village of Bantwal Taluk Dakshina Kannada District

The North - West side of the presently proposed area adjoining the reserved forest boundary is encroached upon by 2 persons belonging to Scheduled Caste and FOC No.122/2002-03 and 123/2002-03 have been booked by the Range forest officer, Bantwal Range. Further, since the provisions of Forest Rights Act, 2006 are applicable to the said encroachers; it is difficult to relocate/shift the proposed site for Gram Panchayath office as per the site inspection. In this regard Range Forest Officer, Bantwal has also submitted village map and forest block map of Maninalkuru showing the proposed forest land and encroachment there upon (Copies of the maps are enclosed).

The Deputy Commissioner, D.K District, Mangaluru vide No. LND(2) CR-33/2017 (E-16420) dated 25-09-2017 has furnished requisite certificate pertaining to compliance of the Scheduled Tribes and Other Traditional Forest Dwellers (Recognition of Forest Rights) Act,2006 as per MoEF's letter No.11-9/98- FC(Pt.) dated 05-07-2013 in Form – II.

b) The proposal for such diversion (with full details of the projects and its implications, in vernacular/ local language) have been placed before each concerned Gram Sabha of forest dwellers, who are eligible under the Forest Right Act 2006(No.2 of 2007) And Rules 2008.

c) each of concerned Gram Sabha(s), has certified all formalities/ processes under the FRA have been carried out and that they have given their consent to the proposed diversion and the compensation ameliorative measures, if any, having understood the purpose and details of proposed diversion . A copy of certificate issued by the Gram Sabha of Maninalkuru Grama Panchayat Bantwala Taluk Dakshina kannada District is enclosed as annexure A

d) Discussion and Decisions on such proposals had taken place only when there was a quorum of minimum 50 % of the members of Gram Sabha present;

e) The diversion of forest land for facilities managed by the Government as required under section 3(2) of the FRA have been completed and the Gram Sabhas have given their consent to it;

f) The rights of Primitive Tribal Groups and Pre –Agricultural Committees, where applicable have been specifically safeguarded as per section 3(1) (e) of the FRA.
